ROUTES TO THE SHOW

From Route 22: to Murray H. Goodman Campus. Take Route 22 to the main Bethlehem exit (Route 378). Route 378 (Wyandotte Street) heads only south; continue for 3.6 miles and when you cross the bridge over the Lehigh River, be careful to stay in the right lane. Continue south on 378 over the top of the mountain. At the top of the mountain there is a light and a gasoline station on your left. Proceed to the next light and make a left-hand turn onto Seidersville Road. Continue until the road forks; bear right. Follow to stop sign and turn left onto Mountain Drive South. Continue for half a mile and the Goodman campus is on the right.

From Interstate 78 (Exit #67 Hellertown/Bethlehem - Route 412): to Murray H. Goodman Campus. Motorists coming from I-78 should use the Hellertown exit. At the exit turn left onto Route 412 South and continue to third traffic light (look for blue sign that reads "Lehigh University"), and make a right onto Water Street (becomes Friedensville Road); travel a half-mile to traffic island (look for blue sign); bear right onto Mountain Drive South and the entrance to Murray H. Goodman Campus is on the right.

From Route 378 off Route 309 (Northeastern Extension of PA Turnpike - Exit 32): to Murray H. Goodman Campus. After taking Exit 44 off the Northeastern Extension of the PA Turnpike, turn left on Route 663 and travel to Route 309. Turn left onto Route 309 in Quakerstown. Traveling north on 309 to Center Valley, bear right at fork onto Route 378 North (to Bethlehem) and travel about two miles to Saucon Valley Road. Turn right onto Saucon Valley Road and follow to end. Turn left onto Bingen Road and travel approximately one mile (look for blue sign that reads "Goodman Campus"). At the intersection, cross over to stop sign. Then go straight onto Mountain Drive South and Goodman Campus is on the right.

4. The day of the show, the building will be open from 6:00 AM to 11:00 PM
5. DUE TO PAST ABUSES, saving space in the grooming/crating areas WILL NOT be permitted. The crating area will be under the supervision and direction of the Club Members and PHA.
ANYONE NOT ADHERING TO CRATING RULES WILL BE SUBJECT TO A BUNCH SHOW COMMITTEE HEARING
6. Exhibitors with multiple crates MUST stack crates on top of each other and ALL crates MUST be arranged in an orderly fashion to MAXIMIZE the use of the LIMITED space available.
7. Due to space limits, NO DOGS may be entered for "Exhibition Only" and there will be NO SPACE for unentered dogs.
8. No chairs in the grooming area.
No crates will be allowed in the aisles. NO soft-sided crates. All crates must be stacked. THESE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED!
