Ramps at the sole discretion of the judge, approved breeds may be examined on the ground or on a ramp: Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chow Chows, Chinese Shar-Pei, Clumber Spaniels, Irish Terriers, Keeshound, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Sussex Spaniels, Whippets, Kerry Blue Terriers and Staffordshire Bull Terriers. (Whippets may be examined on the ground, on a table or on a ramp).

- Basset Hounds are expected to be judged on the ramp during breed judging.
- For the Judging of Juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp breeds.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

Nassau Veterans Memorial Coliseum

NOTE: Commercial Vehicles are not allowed on Parkways. Please follow directions below.

From Upstate New York - New York Thruway to the Throgs Neck Bridge to Queens, pick up the Grand Central Parkway east which turns into the Northern State Parkway, to exit 31A (Meadowbrook Parkway South) to Exit M4, follow signs to the Nassau Coliseum.

From Connecticut - Connecticut Thruway (I-95) to the Throgs Neck Bridge to the LI Expressway east (495) to exit 38, the Northern State Parkway east to exit 31A (Meadowbrook Parkway South) to Exit M4, follow signs to the Nassau Coliseum.

From Southern or Central New Jersey - New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 13, Goethals Bridge, across the Verrazano Narrows Bridge to Belt Parkway East to Southern State Parkway (25A) to Southern State Parkway (25A) to Exit 22N (Meadowbrook Parkway North) to Exit M4, follow signs to the Nassau Coliseum.

From Northern New Jersey - George Washington Bridge to Triborough Bridge to the Grand Central Parkway east which turns into the Northern State Parkway to Exit 31A (Meadowbrook Parkway South) to Exit M4, follow signs to the Nassau Coliseum.

Commercial Vehicles - Travel East on Long Island Expressway/I-495 to Exit 39 South, which is the Glen Cove Road Exit. Travel South on Glen Cove Road approximately 3 miles to Old Country Road. Old Country Road is the first traffic signal after driving under a railroad trestle and see the Carle Place Diner on the left side/North East Corner. Make left onto Old Country Road and travel East approximately 1.5 miles to Merrick Avenue. Go South on Merrick Avenue approximately 1.3 miles passing five (5) traffic signals. Once past the fifth light, stay in right lane and look for a small sign on the rough shoulder for Charles Lindbergh Blvd./Coliseum & Nassau Community College. As you approach the sixth traffic signal, make the soft right onto Lindbergh Blvd. Proceed on Lindbergh Blvd. to the next traffic signal which is Earl Ovington Blvd. Make left onto Earl Ovington Blvd and go to next traffic signal then make left into NVMC parking fields. See plows and storage containers on drivers left.

From Eastern Long Island (South Shore) - Sunrise Highway to Southern State Parkway to exit 22N (Meadowbrook Parkway North) to Exit M4, follow signs to the Nassau Coliseum.

From Eastern Long Island (North Shore) - Long Island Expressway (495) West to Northern State Parkway to Exit 31A (Meadowbrook Parkway South) to exit M4, follow signs to the Nassau Coliseum.
