The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

**CLOSING DATE** for entries 12:00 NOON, Wednesday, January 27, 2010 at Show Secretary's Office after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.
