CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

BUMP UPS will be allowed.

ALL DOGS SHOULD ARRIVE 15 minutes before judging time.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when requested.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise ring.

NO DOGS ALLOWED IN CAFETERIA.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

ADMISSION: Adults \$3.00; Children under 12, \$2.00; Children under 4, Free. All Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Seniors \$2.00.

THIS TRIAL IS UNBENCHED. Dogs may enter or leave the grounds at will. It is the sole responsibility of the handler to insure availability of dogs at the ringside when called for.

DOGS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO ROAM ON HIGH SCHOOL PROPERTY. Dogs must only be exercised in the areas provided.

DOGS WILL BE JUDGED in catalog order to the extent that it is practical to do so without holding up the judging in any ring for a dog that is entered in more than one class at this trial.

BITCHES IN SEASON. Since bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience Trials, all but \$2.50 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason, will be refunded. To be eligible for such refund the Show Superintendent must be notified by letter postmarked January 17, 2010 or earlier, together with a veterinarian's certificate confirming the fact that the bitch is in season.

Effective May 1, 2006 an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Effective January 1, 2009 - Refund and Cash award checks are void after 180 days and will NOT be re-issued.
