### Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

**Veteran Classes,** For any dog or bitch which is 8 years old or older prior to the date of this show. Classes shall be divided: 8 years and under 10 years, 10 years and over. Sexes divided.

**Hunting Retriever Classes,** Classes for dogs and bitches that have earned an AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter Title. Sexes divided.

**Bred-by-Exhibitor Class eligibility:** All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The Person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

**Amateur-Owner-Handler eligibility:** For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler.

## BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

### Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Entries

**Stud Dog Class:** For Stud Dog and two (2) of his get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Award will be based on the merits of the get. If the Get are not entered in one of the other Classes in this show for which it is eligible the regular entry fee must be paid. Entry fee is \$28.00 for Stud Dog Class only, \$18.00 as an additional entry.

**Brood Bitch Class:** Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. In accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8 - a castrated male may be entered in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

**Veteran's Obedience Class.** The Veterans Class shall be for dogs that have an obedience title and are eight or more years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Dog Class. Dogs entered in the Veterans class may not be entered in any Regular Class. A Rosette will be presented to each dog with its name and titles.

**Brace Class.** The Brace Class will be for two dogs of the same breed that are eligible under these Regulations and capable of performing the Novice exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person but will be handled by one handler. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled (the coupling device will not be less than 6 inches in overall length). Whichever method is used will be continued throughout all exercises. A separate official entry form will be completed in full for each dog entered. Exercises, performances and judging will be as in the Novice Class. The brace should work in unison at all times. Either or both dogs in a brace may be entered in another class or classes.

**Team Class.** This Class will be for teams of any four dogs that are eligible under these Regulations. Five dogs may be entered, one to be considered an alternate for which no entry fee will be required. However, the same four dogs will perform all exercises. Dogs may be handled by the owner or any other person, need not be entered in another class at the same trial, and need not have obedience titles. A separate official entry form will be completed in full for each dog entered.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.
