### **New Jersey State Fair Sussex County Farm & Horse Show**

#### **New Electrical Requirements for 2009**

The State of New Jersey, Department of Community Affairs, an overseer of fairgrounds in the State of New Jersey, has informed us of the need to meet the National Electrical Code Requirements for portable cords. The purpose is to inform you that all cords must be UL listed as extra hard usage, wet location and sunlight resistant (Article 525.20) (A) (E) and (G). **SOOW** and **W** are acceptable. **W** is necessary if over 100 AMP. **The cord must be rated for extra hard usage.**

In addition, the electrical staff is required by the code to check the continuity of the equipment grounding conductor each time the portable cords are put into use. (Article 525.32).

If you wish to purchase these approved portable cords from the fairgrounds, they can be cut to the length you need or wish and assembled with appropriate plugs and connectors. Otherwise, you must come to the fairgrounds with the appropriate portable cords and assemblies.

#### **OVERNIGHT PARKING AT THE HARVEST CLUSTER**
