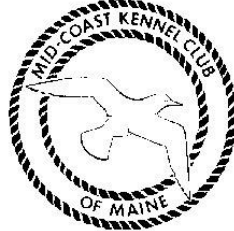

All entries must be signed by the owner or authorized agent. Errors on entry forms are the responsibility of the owner. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management and it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded for dogs that are absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition.

The trial will be open from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. Dogs may arrive any time prior to scheduled time of judging. Judges are not required to wait for dog that are late. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. **There will be no access to the trial grounds for set up prior to the trial date.**

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring. Problems relating to conflicts in class schedules should be brought to the Steward's/Judge's attention prior to the start of judging that class.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

There will be no parking in the Student Parking lot as there will be workers sweeping there. There is ample parking around the perimeter of the school. **THERE IS NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON THESE GROUNDS.**

Transfers will be allowed. The request for a transfer must be made in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
