Returned/Re-deposited checks do not constitute a valid entry.

MOVE UP REQUESTS

Move ups must be sent in writing (**e-mail is acceptable and preferred--NO TEXTS OR INSTANT MESSAGES**) to the Trial Secretary for the May 6, 2019 trial, no later than Sunday, May 5, 2019, by 6:00 PM. The trial secretary will be more than grateful if you will do your move-ups as soon as possible.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to **only pure-bred Irish Setters** fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Entry is further limited to Irish Setters only.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

PLEASE NOTE:

Effective 1/2/18, the 26-inch jump height division is replaced by the 24-Choice jump height division.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section on the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place on mowed grass. Electronic timers will be used. The ring for all classes will be approximately 110 ft. X 110 ft.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The ISCA and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The ISCA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the ISCA or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, It is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Refunds are not issued for less than \$10. No refunds will be issued other than for bitches in season.

BITCHES IN SEASON will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run, upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than the start time on the date of the trial

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

This club does NOT agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

ISCA Endorses and supports the AKC's current policy on the misuse of service dogs.

The use of alcoholic beverages during the running of any performance/companion event is not condoned by the ISCA and is strictly prohibited.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From North (Johnson City, TN) – Travel south on Hwy 19/23 (also known as I-26E), merge onto I-240W. Stay in the right lane as you merge, marked as an “Exit Only” for Exit 3-B (labeled Westgate and Resort Dr). Merge into the right lane as you pass the Westgate Shopping Center. Resort driveway is IMMEDIATELY as you round the curve to your right.

From South (Asheville Regional Airport; Greenville/Spartanburg, SC; Columbia, SC) – Travel west on I-26, follow signs for I-240 to Asheville. Merge into the left lane and take exit 3-A which will merge you onto Patton Ave. At the second light, make a right onto Regent Park Blvd (between Denny's and Pizza Hut). The road will bear right and the Resort entrance will be immediately on the left (before entering Sam's Club parking lot). Follow Resort road past the golf course to the main entrance.

From East (Hickory, Winston-Salem, Greensboro, Raleigh, NC) – Travel west on I-40, take exit 53-B onto I-240W towards downtown Asheville. As you cross the “French Broad River Bridge”, merge into the far right lane, marked as an “Exit Only” for Exit 3-B (labeled Westgate and Resort Dr). Merge into the right lane as you pass the Westgate Shopping Center. Resort driveway is IMMEDIATELY as you round the curve to your right.

From West (Knoxville, TN) – Travel east on I-40, follow signs for I-240E towards Asheville (left exit). Merge into the left lane and take exit 3-A which will merge you onto Patton Ave. At the second light, make a right onto Regent Park Blvd (between Denny's and Pizza Hut). The road will bear right and the Resort entrance will be immediately on the left (before entering Sam's Club parking lot). Follow Resort road past the golf course to the main entrance.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

In all areas of competition, a rosette will be awarded to any dog completing a title. A rosette will be awarded at each individual trial to all dogs earning a Double Q (STD & JWW), Triple Q or Quad Q, for all levels. ISCA Bronze Medallions for first through fourth places for all levels.

HIGH IN TRIAL in each trial will receive a Bronze Trophy with Irish Setter Motif offered by the Irish Setter Club of America, Inc. Two High in Trials (HIT) will be awarded on the basis of number of Q's - one for Regular jump heights and one for Preferred classes. High in Trial will be calculated as follows:

1. All Irish Setters competing in all levels.
2. Only Standard and JWW classes to count.
3. The total number of Q's earned.
4. The dog with the highest total score for Q's earned.

Tie Breakers:

1. Average yards per second for all Q's.
2. Dog with the highest level Q's.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
