Amateur-Owner-Handler - For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, any any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Classes, For any dog or bitch which is 8 years old or older prior to the date of this show. Classes shall be divided: 8 years and under 10 years, 10 years and over. Sexes divided.

Hunting Retriever Dogs and Bitches - For Dogs and Bitches that have earned a Junior, Senior or Master Hunter title under AKC rules.

Field Trial Dogs and Bitches - Class for dogs & class for bitches that have placed in a Regular Derby, Gundog, or an All Age Stake at a licensed AKC Field Trial.

Best Puppy - Rosette.
Best Veteran - Rosette.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record; Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of a show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the American Kennel Club.

Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of judging.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dog and two (2) of his get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of get. The Stud Dog and his get shall be considered as one entry and require only one class fee. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Get only are to be judged based on the merits of the Get. The Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed, other Non-Regular class or entered for Stud Dog class only.

Brood Bitch Class: For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the Produce. Produce only are to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce. The Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed, other Non-Regular Class, or entered for Brood Bitch Class only.

Chapter 14, Section 9 of the Dog Show Rules provides that "a castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".

Parade of Titleholders - Fee - \$10.00

Judges' Award of Merit - This award is given at the Judge's discretion. The Award of Merit winners will be selected after the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed & Best of Winners awards are made. All dogs remaining in competition are eligible for an Award of Merit. The number of awards will be up to 10% of the Best of Breed entry.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW GROUNDS

- From North & South Via Interstate 295:** Take 295 to Exit 65A, Sloane Avenue. East on Sloane Avenue to Second traffic light, Quaker Bridge Road. Cross over Quaker Bridge Road and go to next traffic light (road makes a T) at Old Trenton/Edinburg Road (Route 535), Turn left onto Old Trenton/Edinburg Road, Mercer County park is about two miles ahead on left.
- From North Via U.S. 1:** Take US 1 South of Princeton to Rt. 533, Quaker Bridge Road. Bear Right off US 1 into jughandle and cross over US 1 onto Rt. 533, Quaker Bridge Road. Travel 2.2 miles and turn left onto Hughes Drive. At the first traffic light, turn left onto Old Trenton/Edinburg Road, Route 535. Travel about 1.5 miles on Route 535 to the exhibitors' entrance to the Park on the left.
- From South Via U.S. Route 1:** Cross toll bridge into New Jersey. On U.S. 1 make first right past Quaker Bridge Mall onto Quaker Bridge Road (Route 533). Travel 2.2 miles and turn left onto Hughes Drive. Make left at traffic light onto Old Trenton/Edinburg Road (Route 535) and proceed to the exhibitor's entrance about 1.65 miles on left.
- From North (Route 130S) Turnpike Exit 8 A:** Exit 8 A toward Rt. 130 South. Go to the 6th light and turn right onto Old Trenton Road (Rt. 535). Go through 4 traffic lights. MC Park is on right just ahead.
- From South Via NJ Route 130/206:** Follow Route 130 North to Route 526 in Robbinsville. Turn left at traffic light onto Route 526. (Corners: Costal Delta Station, Russert's Deli). Turn right at the next traffic light; you are still on Route 526. From this point travel 3 miles to Route 535, Old Trenton/Edinburg Road and turn left. The exhibitor's entrance to the show grounds is about 1/3 miles ahead on the right side.
- From South Via New Jersey Turnpike:** Take NJ Turnpike South to Exit 7A. Take Interstate 195 West to Exit 5B which is the first exit on Route 195 To Route 130 North, New Brunswick. Travel North on Route 130 to second traffic light and turn left onto Route 526. Proceed to the next traffic light and turn right (still Route 526). There may be a detour on Rt. 526. Follow signs. Go 3 miles to Route 535 and turn left. The park exhibitors' entrance is 1/3 miles ahead on the right.

- CANINE COURTESY** All dogs shall be kept under control at all times. You are responsible for picking up after the animals in your care.
- PLEASE EXERCISE DOGS IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY** There will be pooper scoopers and containers placed around the grounds. **PLEASE USE THEM.** All regulations will be enforced by the Grounds Committee.
- DECLINATION OF ENTRIES** The Lenape Golden Retriever Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Lenape Golden Retriever Club or any official thereof.
- NO GASOLINE OR DIESEL GENERATORS** are permitted within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is being conducted.
