DIRECTIONS

From Baltimore: From Baltimore Beltway 695, take #795 North to 140 North towards Westminster. Follow 140 to Center Street. Turn left onto Center, take Center Street to Gist Road (you will pass farm museum and Carroll County General Hospital on Center Street). Turn right onto Gist Road and follow to stop sign. Turn right onto Smith Avenue. Follow Smith Avenue to Extension Office, (Smith Avenue dead ends at the AG Center Complex).

From Western MD: Travel on I-70 to the Mt. Airy/Route 27 Ex. Proceed North towards Westminster on Route 27 for approximately 15 miles. Route 27 intersects with Kate Wagner Road. Make a right onto Kate Wagner Road and follow it approximately 1.2 miles. At bottom of the hill, make a left onto Gist Road, proceed on Gist Road to stop sign and make a left onto Smith Avenue. Smith Avenue dead ends at the AG Center.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The Show-giving club and the Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent to be advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES.

ONE EXHIBITOR'S ADMISSION TICKET will be issued for each Dog entered.

SURRENDER OF IDENTIFICATION CARD must be made to the clerk when requested for removing dogs from the show.

SPECIAL PLACES will be provided in the crate section for the cleaning and preparation of dogs for exhibition. Grooming tables in excess of 24 x 36 inches will not be permitted. The grooming of dogs in areas other than the crate section is not permitted.

EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates.

ANY OUTSIDE AREAS USED FOR WALKING AND EXERCISING DOGS MUST BE PICKED UP AND KEPT CLEAN.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS: Dryers will be allowed in designated area only. No powdering of dogs will be permitted at any place in the building at any time.

An Administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Effective January 1, 2009 - Refund and Cash award checks are void after 180 days and will **NOT** be re-issued.

Effective May 1, 2006 an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
