ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- ◆No alcohol will be permitted on the grounds.
- ◆There is no electricity available in the grooming area.
- ◆By entering these shows you acknowledge that the Park Rangers are the final authority in interpreting and enforcing the Park Rules. Any abuse of the facility or damage to hotel/motel facilities will be deemed prejudicial to the sport of purebred dogs and may be subject to action by the Show Committee.
- ◆Vendors and/or Exhibitors who will be driving stakes of any kind must clear this with the Park Rangers prior to set up.
- ◆There will be no water or electric available to any vehicles unless they have been assigned an approved site through the Parking Chairman, Mr. Harry Miller.
- ◆Please help us to retain this site by cleaning up after your dog and disposing trash in the receptacles provided throughout the grounds.
- ◆The Park is a smoke free facility: NO Smoking/Vaping or Chewing. This will be enforced by Park Rangers.
- ◆Dogs must be on a leash at all time.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent to be advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

ENTRY FORM CHANGES, additions or corrections MUST be received in writing or by telegram prior to the closing of entries. Those received by telephone are NOT acceptable.

IF, BECAUSE OF RIOTS, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

THE SHOW-GIVING CLUB, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility of injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

Effective May 1, 2006 an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

East Freehold Park, Kozloski Road, Freehold, NJ

GARDEN STATE PARKWAY

FROM THE NORTH - Take Exit 117A; then turn right (toward Aberdeen/Matawan).
Go West on Lloyd Road for three miles to Route 79.
Turn left on Route 79 and go 7 miles to Kozloski Road.
Turn left and proceed 3 miles to East Freehold Park (Show Grounds) on the right.

FROM THE SOUTH - Take Exit 100B (toward Freehold).
Go West on Hwy 33.
Follow Hwy 33 to Exit Halls Mill Road North
Road name changed to Kozloski Road
Follow signs to Park on left.

STATE HIGHWAY 9

to Hwy. 33 East, south of Freehold. Follow Hwy. 33 to Halls Mill Road North Exit. Follow Halls Mill Rd. North to intersection. Road name will change to Kozloski Rd. Follow Kozloski Rd. to Park on left.

STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 18

Take Exit 22B and proceed West on Route 537 to Kozloski Road.
Turn right and follow new signs Route 55 South/Kozloski Road.
Follow signs on Kozloski Road to Park on the right.

FROM THE NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE

Take to Exit 8 to Hwy. 33 East. Stay on Hwy. 33 East (Do NOT exit at Freehold Business District). Exit to Halls Mill Road North which becomes County Road 55. Continue on Rt. 55 (Kozloski Road) through second light to East Freehold Park on left.
