

Directions to our Lure Field Trial

From the North -

From Hopewell, take Rt. 10 East for 29.7 miles. Turn right onto Martin Luther King Highway (VA 40) for five miles, turn left onto Carsley Road (VA 615) for 3.7 miles. Then turn right onto Carsley Road and field will be on the right in about 1/2 mile.

From the South -

From Emporia, get on Rt. 95 North towards Richmond for 19.8 miles, take Exit 31 (VA 40) towards Waverly/Sussex Courthouse for 28.1 miles. Turn right onto Carsley Road (VA 615) for 3.7 miles. Turn right again onto Carsley Road and field will be on the right in about 1/2 mile.

From Jamestown/Williamsburg -

Take VA 31 towards the Jamestown/Scotland Ferry. Ferry is free, but check schedule for departure times. Continue on VA 31 for 14.6 miles, then turn right onto Carsley Road. The field is on the left in 2.9 miles. Ferry schedule can be found here:

From Founders Inn -

Follow I-64, US-13, US-58W and US-460 W for 51.5 mi to E main St. in Wakefield. Turn Right onto Carsley Road for 2.9 miles to the field on the left.

From Hampton/Newport News -

Take the James River Bridge (Rt 17S), then turn right onto Brewer's Neck Blvd. (Rt. 32/258) for 2.8 miles. Turn right onto Benn's Church Blvd. (Rt. 10) for 22 miles. Turn left at the light in Surry (VA 10/31) for 10.3 miles. Turn right onto Carsley Road for 2.9 miles to the field on the left.

From Portsmouth/Chesapeake -

Take 17 North into Isle of Wight County (Carrollton). Turn left onto Brewers Neck Blvd. (Rt. 32/258) for 2.8 miles. Turn right onto Benn's Church Blvd. (Rt. 10) for 22 miles. Turn left at the light in Surry (VA 10/31) for 10.3 miles. Turn right onto Carsley Road for 2.9 miles to the field on the left. **Pet-Friendly Lodging** There are numerous motels in the Williamsburg area. Eligible Breeds and Registry

Only purebred Afghan Hounds may be entered. All entries shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club, the United Kennel Club. Dogs with an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or a Purebred Alternate Listing (PAL) from the American Kennel Club shall be considered registered with that body. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry

TRIAL HOURS 1:00 PM to conclusion of trial awards ceremony
ROLL CALL 1 PM

STAKES OFFERED:

JUNIOR COURSER TEST: Open to all Afghan Hounds at least 12 months of age. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge assigned to one test and a second certification from a different judge assigned to another test, stating that the hound completed a 600-yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

QUALIFIED COURSER TEST: Open to all Afghan Hounds at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed—or another breed with a similar running style—(Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course.

OPEN STAKE (trial): Open to any eligible Afghan Hound that has obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate prior to close of entries. QC Certificate must be submitted to the host club along with the entry form the first time the hound is entered in the AKC Open Stake. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). A copy of the hound's ASFA or CKC Field Champion Certificate must be submitted to the host club along with the entry form the first time the hound is entered in the AKC Open Stake

SPECIALS STAKE (trial): Open to any eligible Afghan Hound that has earned AKC Field Championship title.

OPEN VETERAN STAKE (trial): Open to any Afghan Hound which is eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and is 7 years or older on the day of the trial.

Single Stake: Any eligible Afghan Hounds including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles stake. Limited breeds are not eligible for these titles.

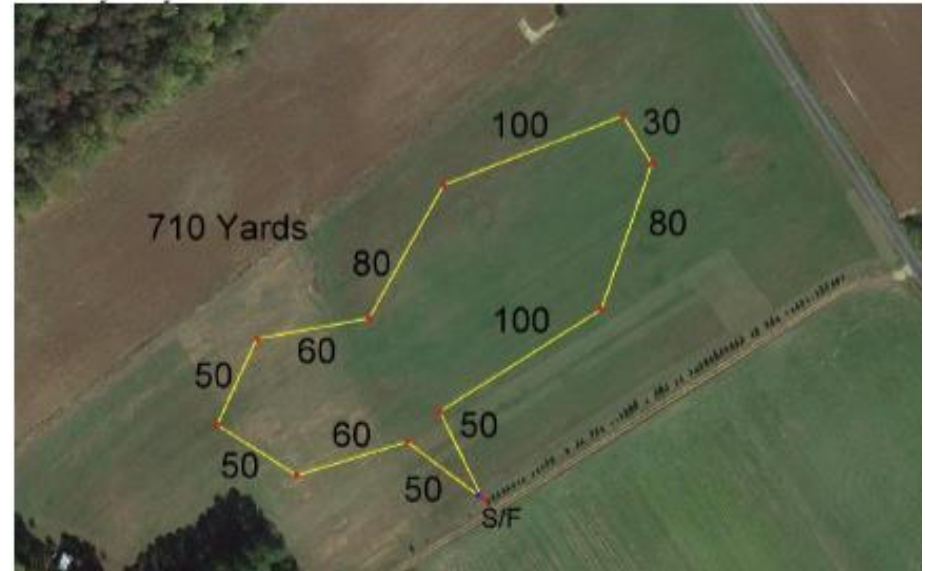

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.
- Stakes will be split into flights by random public draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more
- Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused.
- Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched.
- Handler responsible for providing testing hound for certification
- Refunds will not be given except for circumstances listed:
Hounds determined to have a breed disqualification at the time of roll call shall be barred from competition and their entry fees shall be refunded. Spayed, monorchid, cryptorchid, and neutered hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered (b) Hounds determined to be lame at the time of roll call shall be barred from competition and their entry fees shall be refunded. (c) Bitches in season, or bitches showing a discharge characteristic of being in season, or which come in season after the close of entries, shall be excepted from this rule and their entry fees shall be refunded. Notification to the field secretary of bitches in season must be made before or during the roll call. Bitches known to be in season should not be brought onto the trial grounds. (d) Hounds that have been disqualified, or which do not meet the requirements for entry, are also eligible to have their entry fees refunded by check within 90 days of the trial. Fees will be refunded only if the owner or agent notifies the field secretary of such ineligibility prior to or during roll call.
- Battery powered; continuous loop lure machines will be used.
- The lure will consist of plastic contrasting in color with the immediate field environment.
- Each hound requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.
- Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC/AHCA/any hound(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.
- The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators.
- All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the club. All persons and animals attending these shows grant the club the right to use their likeness and voice in any matter without further consent.
- A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hounds not competing in the course in progress.
- A return check fee of \$35.00 will be assessed for any check(s) returned for insufficient funds.
- Field Committee Members and Trial Volunteers may have their hounds inspected prior to the designated inspection time by the full inspection committee.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not allowed
