Directions to Site

FROM US 422:

Take Route 202 South approximately 10 miles.

Take the US-30 **Business** Route/US-30 East exit toward EXTON/FRAZER. At the bottom of the exit ramp, turn RIGHT onto LINCOLN HWY/US-30 **BUSINESS** West. Go approximately 1 mile on East LINCOLN HWY/US 30 **BUSINESS** WEST.

Turn LEFT onto SPRINGDALE DRIVE. The East Lincoln Highway entrance to Springdale Drive is posted "Whiteland Business Park."

Dog Training Center of Chester County (DTCCC) is the 1st building on the left. The entrance faces Springdale Drive. Look for black awning above the door. Parking is available around the building and in the lot across from the front entrance.

FROM PA Turnpike from the East:

Exit PA Turnpike at the Valley Forge Exit. Follow signs for 202 South. Follow as above.

FROM PA Turnpike from the West:

Exit PA Turnpike at the Downingtown Exit (#312). Take Route 100 South for 4.5 miles. Turn Left onto Route 30 **BUSINESS**. Go 1.5 miles and turn right on Springdale Drive. Follow as above.

FROM I-95 from the South:

Exit US-202N/Concord Pike (Exit 8). Go about 20 miles. Exit onto Route 30 **Business**. Go approximately 1 mile and turn left on Springdale Drive. Follow as above.

Unloading at the building is permitted – flashers should be left on, 10 minutes max.

Admission to the building for exhibitors will be no earlier than one hour before first walk-thru

There is no space for un-entered dogs. Dogs may not be left overnight.

Indoor restroom facilities available.

The ring dimensions are a minimum 2,000 square feet, with a minimum width of 30 feet.

Rules of the Venue

- 1- No OVERNIGHT RV PARKING before, during, or after the event are permitted anywhere on the grounds.
- 2- No electrical hookups for RVs are available.
- 3- Generators and propane tanks are not permitted in the building nor on the grounds.
- 4- No tents or private exercises pens are permitted to be set up anywhere on the grounds.
- 5- Dogs must be exercised/curbed in the designated party area and not on landscaping in the grounds, as noted by signs prohibiting dogs in foundation landscaping.
- 6- Smoking is prohibited in the building.

POLICIES AND INFORMATION REGARDING COVID-19

- Exhibitors are reminded of the importance of complying with all federal, state, local, venue, and club requirements for the mitigation of COVID-19 infection. Failure to do so may result in a disciplinary hearing and/or dismissal from the trial site. Do not attend the trials if you do not feel well. If you have been recently exposed to someone with a recent positive test for active infection, do not attend.
- Per order of the Pennsylvania Department of Health, face coverings must be worn over nose and mouth at all times while indoors in a public setting.
- No food will be served or sold at these events. Exhibitors are advised to plan accordingly.
- No crating is allowed inside the building. We will be using the Remind app to provide status information.
- No photographer will be available.
- Exhibitors are also reminded that the entry agreement contains the following waiver and applies to COVID-19 infection. Any non-handler wishing to enter the building will be required to sign an agreement to this effect. "I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties [VFKC and DTCCC] harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons."
- In the event of an unanticipated cancellation of these trials, entry fees will be refunded based on net proceeds less refund administration costs except when such refund would be less than 15% of the entry fee.

Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crating area. No wire crates or ex-pens on the matted floors without something underneath them to protect the floor. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, superintendent and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The trial committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these trials.
