

The Pennsylvania Health Secretary issued an order today updating travel and mask mandates for the state. The new rules that may apply to exhibitors, effective 11/20/20, are as follows:

- 1) Masks - must be worn indoors, regardless of whether you can maintain social distancing of 6 feet. Masks must be worn outdoors, when the recommended social distancing of 6 feet cannot be maintained.

*This requirement is already addressed by our best practices policy which can be located in our premium list.

- 2) Travel – anyone entering from another state must have a negative COVID test within 72 hours prior to entry or quarantine for 14 days.

*This is a state mandate and any efforts to enforce the testing mandate will be enforced by the State of Pennsylvania, not the officers and/or chairpersons of the individual shows. We advise individuals that carrying proof of your test results is the easiest way to avoid issues if you are confronted by officials from the state.
