JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

NOVICE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards, with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present, in the Novice Class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open Class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NOTICE

Juniors with a dog also entered in another class offered at this show who substitute a dog not entered in this show must remit the difference between Junior Showmanship Only and Junior Showmanship as an Additional Class Entry Fee. Juniors who have entered Junior Showmanship only who then substitute another dog will not be charged a further fee.

- THESE SHOWS ARE CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC. NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED.
- Masks must be worn at all times while on the grounds by everyone over the age of two. Please bring your own.
- Everyone that attends the cluster must sign the waiver that is available in the premium list and judging program. Everyone must submit a waiver in order to receive a wristband. Wristbands must be worn at all times while on the grounds. Access to any show area will be permitted only to those wearing the wristband.
- Exhibitors should follow their doctor's advice on attending the shows if they are in a high-risk group for COVID-19.
- Fairgrounds will not be available until Thursday at 3:00 pm. The gate will close at 10:00 pm every night except Sunday. On Sunday, the gate will close one hour after the conclusion of BIS.
- Fairgrounds' gate will open each morning of the shows at 6:00 am.
- No public seating will be available anywhere on show grounds. You are welcome to bring your own chair. Social distancing will be enforced.
- Ringside crating will be available in designated areas only. The area will be available 15 minutes before and after your breed is being judged. Please be mindful of other exhibitors and please adhere to the 15-minute rule.
- There will be no catalogs available at the rings. Please prepare the list of armband numbers that you need before you visit the steward. Catalogs may be purchased for individual use.
- Crate fans are allowed for dogs but must be attached to the crate.
- Please stack crates for small and medium sized dogs. You may be directed to do so by Site Control so please come prepared with boards and anything else you may need to stack crates.
- Cooperation with all club members, Event Committee members, RV parking personnel and Brooklyn Fairgrounds Security is mandatory. Following instructions and directions is required at all times. Using rude, abusive, or foul language, or arguing or behaving objectionably against club officials, RV parking

If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3.) All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of **\$20.00** will be made for each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

An administrative Fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is Limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list, if the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.).
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
