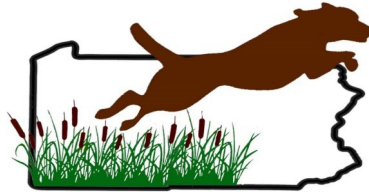

\*Chapter 3, Section 7 - The Amateur-Owner-Handler Class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

#### **Non-Regular Classes Involving Single-Dog Entries**

##### Veteran Classes

(8yrs and under 10 yrs & 10 yrs and over)

Class for dogs & class for bitches eight (8) years old & under 10 years.

Entry fee is \$32.00 as a first entry & \$25.00 as an additional entry.

Class for dogs & class for bitches 10 years old & over. Entry fee is \$32.00 as a first entry & \$25.00 as an additional entry.

##### Hunting Classes

Open to Chesapeake Bay Retriever dogs or bitches that have earned an AKC Junior, Senior or Master Hunter title. Sexes divided. Entry fee is \$32.00 as a first entry & \$25.00 as an additional entry.

##### Field Trial Classes

Open to Chesapeake Bay Retriever dogs or bitches that has received a JAM or better at an AKC licensed or member field trial. Sexes divided. Entry fee is \$32.00 as a first entry & \$25.00 as an additional entry.

### **BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

#### **Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple-Dog Entries**

##### Stud Dog Class

For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed. Entry fee is \$32.00 as a first entry & \$25.00 as an additional entry.

### Brood Bitch Class

Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

As the judges' decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

### Brace Class

Two Dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated, "Brace no. 1," "Brace no. 2" etc. Entry fee is \$25.00 per unit

## BEGINNER PUPPY SPECIAL ATTRACTION (AKC SANCTIONED)

Use Entry Form and mark 4-6 Month Class in Dog Show Class.

One combined class will be offered puppies that are four months and under six months of age. There will be a selection of Best of Breed Puppy and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed Puppy. Puppies are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized. *AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct* will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4-6 month Puppy Special Attraction event. To immediately follow.

### National Owner-Handled Series

*(REMEMBER TO CHECK THE BOX NEAR THE BOTTOM OF THE ENTRY FORM)*

The AKC Owner/Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. This series of special competitions will be offered at dog shows across the country.

All dogs that are owner/handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers' meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner/Handler eligible the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the competition by an eligible owner.**

**Professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.**

The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner Handled Best of Breed.
- If the Best of Breed winner is Owner-Handled competition ineligible and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible undefeated exhibits of the owner sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed are both ineligible and Select Dog and Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all dogs of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are ineligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed.

*\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.*

### CHALLENGE TROPHIES

All Challenge Trophies are offered through the American Chesapeake Club for competition at its National Specialty Show.

For permanent possession must be won three times by the same owner not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows. The Trophy is to remain in the custody of the winning owner until the next National Specialty Show. Persons awarded the American Chesapeake Club Challenge Trophies will be required to sign a release & liability form before claiming the award.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent to be advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

ALL TRASH IS TO BE PICKED UP BY THE OWNER/HANDLER and placed in the proper dumpsters and NOT left on the grounds.

An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
