You may be included in the photograph(s) in whole or in part, in composite or distorted form, or in reproductions thereof, in color or otherwise, with or without your name, made and published through any medium including but not limited to, a printed medium, video, and/or the internet.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Building will be available on Wednesday at 1PM. NO EARLIER.
- Crates, tables, chairs and other grooming equipment will not be allowed in the aisles of the Grooming Building. Grooming tables in excess of 24" x 36" will not be permitted. Tables must be folded when not in use. NO CHAIRS IN THE GROOMING AREA. The grooming of dogs in areas other than the Educational Building or Outside by your vehicle is not permitted.
- Crates and small ringside tables will be allowed in designated areas near your ring 15 minutes before your breed's designated judging time and 15 minutes after your breed's end judging. No scissoring, clipper work, bathing etc. in the main ring building, NO exceptions!
- NO soft-sided crates will be allowed except in Obedience/Rally building.
- Please stack crates for small and medium sized dogs, you may be directed to do so by Site Control so please come prepared with boards and anything else you may need to stack.
- Co-operation with all Site Control, RV parking personnel and Fairgrounds Security including following instructions and directions is required. The use of rude, abusive or foul language, arguing or objectionable behavior against club officials, Site Control, RV parking personnel and Fairgrounds Security will be immediately subject to a Bench Show Hearing. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Day crating will be available in the Grooming Building. Must remove all after BIS each day
- No EXTENDED Flex-Leads allowed in any building or in the outside ExPen area
- Exhibitors we ask that all STROLLERS be left in the Grooming Building please do not use STROLLERS in the Ring Building.
- Spectators are not allowed to bring STROLLERS into any of the buildings
- Overnight crating. All crates must be labeled with the dog's name and Emergency number
- ALL Buildings will open at 6am Thursday – Sunday and be locked at 10PM each night.
- To find out about any event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Take NE Extension of Pa. Turnpike to Pocono Exit (95). Then 80 West to Exit 232 (Buckhorn) (formerly Exit 34). Follow directions If coming from the East below.

Route 81 Coming from North

Intersect with 80 West to Exit 232 (Buckhorn) (formerly Exit 34). Follow Route 80 Exit 232 (formerly Exit 34) directions below.

Route 80 Exit 232 (Buckhorn) (formerly Exit 34)

If coming from the EAST, turn LEFT onto Route 42 South at light after exit. If coming from the WEST, turn RIGHT onto 42 South at this light. Go 2.5 miles. Follow Route 11 sign to Fairgrounds.

Route 11 South

Coming from the NORTH on Route 11 South. Go through Bloomsburg to Fairgrounds on Left (past Magee Center).

Route 11 North

Coming from the SOUTH on Route 11 North. Turn Right at first building after underpass and Bloomsburg Town Limits sign on Right.

From Reading Area

Take Rt. 61 North to Rt. 42 North to Rt. 11 North. WATCH FOR BLOOMSBURG FAIRGROUNDS SIGNS.
