CRATING AND GROOMING AREA: Crates and tables will not be allowed in the aisles. A set layout for the Crating area will be provided and we ask all exhibitors to conserve space and PLEASE STACK CRATES. NO SOFT SIDED CRATES. Please work together to conserve space. No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside the building.

No chairs will be permitted in the free grooming or crating area. Grooming tables in excess of 24 X 36 inches will not be permitted. The grooming of dogs in areas other than the crate section is not permitted. No outside food is allowed in the ballroom or adjacent grooming areas during show hours. Please keep your area clean.

There will be NO RV parking allowed at the Stamford Hilton.

No generators are allowed and there are no hook-up facilities.

Crating Information

There are reserved/preferred grooming spots as well as free grooming areas. There are 29 spots inside the Grand Ballroom and 15 spots immediately outside the ballroom. Each space is approximately 10 foot deep by 7 ft wide; Cost is \$20 per day. You must have a reservation at the Hilton to reserve in this area.

There is also a reserved grooming area on the mezzanine level for those not staying at the Hilton or those who prefer a less busy area to crate their dogs.

Electricity is \$90 for all three days or \$50 for two days.

Unloading information

All crates, equipment and luggage can be unloaded through the lobby of the Stamford Hilton. There is a ramp leading to 4 elevators. The show site is on the mezzanine (2nd floor) or proceed directly to your room.

For those parking in the Hilton garage (height limit 6 feet 8 inches), there is an elevator from the garage to the Hilton lobby.

For those with many dogs and lots of equipment, there is a loading dock and large freight elevator available in the over-height parking area around the side of the Hilton. NOTE: Crated dogs will be allowed to remain in crating areas overnight. All crated dogs in reserved or free spaces need to be tagged with your name and CELL phone number where you can be reached in case of an emergency. This is an AKC requirement. Important Parking Information for all exhibitors

Parking height limit for the covered garage parking under the Stamford Hilton is 6 ft 8 inches. Parking is \$10 a night for the preferred areas of this garage (first two areas reached), and no charge if vehicles are parking several levels down in the event parking areas of the garage. The event parking area is accessible without going through the gated area of the garage.

Parking for vans, Sprinters etc & box trucks: Everyone with a vehicle over the height of 6 feet 8 inches must fill out a reserved parking form for WGS to know how many vehicles will require alternative parking.

There are two options:

- There are a limited number of PRIME spaces that are in a covered area beyond the loading dock.
