ATTENTION EXHIBITORS & GUESTS

The Specialty Show Area will be available to exhibitors at approximately 11AM on Wednesday, September 27, 2023.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the entire area clean. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dogs on the show/trial grounds will be excused from the trial with no entry fees refunded.

NEW YORK STATE LAW REQUIRES CURRENT RABIES CERTIFICATES FOR ALL DOGS IN PARK.

Only official cluster committee golf carts will be allowed on the show site. "Motorized scooters, bicycles, golf carts and other non-registered motor vehicles are prohibited in Sampson State Park. No Riding of Bicycles or Motorized Bikes on Show Grounds during Show Hours. This prohibition does not include electric wheelchairs or similar devices designed specifically for use by the physically impaired and being used by the person with the recognized handicap."

All persons on the grounds of the Wine Country Circuit dog shows, waive the right to claim damages against a club member who must forcibly enter a vehicle to rescue a dog in obvious life-threatening distress.

Wine Country Circuit Dog Shows is NOT providing electric for the Grooming Tents or Vendors. There will be designated areas for personal generators. You must bring extra electric cords to run from the generators to your setup. Wine Country Circuit is not responsible for personal generators.

Owners of participating Curlies must be members of the CCRCA. Curlies may be handled by members or non-members in any of the events. Curlies need to receive a ribbon in a Field Event (Upland WCs, Retriever WCs or Super Singles), receive a qualifying score in a performance event (Obedience, Rally, Agility or CGC) and receive a ribbon in a conformation event (Sweepstakes/Regular or Non-Regular Classes/BOB).

MASTER CLASS

Novice Class - shall be for minors who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for minors who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - will be for minors who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show. NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

Spayed bitches and neutered dogs are eligible to compete in Veterans. Winners of each Veterans class, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition.

WORKING RETRIEVER DOG CLASS WORKING RETRIEVER BITCH CLASS

A Class for Dogs/Bitches that have a placement or Judge's Award of Merit (JAM) in an AKC licensed or member club Field Trial, an AKC Hunting test title, an AKC Upland title or a CCRCA Working Certificate title (WC, WCX, WCQ, UWC or UWCX). Winners of each class, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition. Altered dogs/bitches may be entered in Working Retriever.

VERSATILITY DOG CLASS VERSATILITY BITCH CLASS

A class for altered dogs/bitches of any age. For Dogs/Bitches entered in the versatility challenge that are spayed and neutered and not eligible for any of the other conformation class. Winners of the versatility classes are not eligible for Best of Breed Competition.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

STUD DOG & BROOD BITCH CLASS: Each entry is allowed two get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch. The Stud Dog/Brood Bitch MAY be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides

that “a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.”

BRACE CLASS (Two dogs of the same breed, one or more common owner) – The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time the entry is made. If a dog which is to be part of the Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for “Brace Class Only”. In making entries for “Brace Class Only,” full particulars must be given for each dog using the individual, regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for “Additional Class.” If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated “Brace No. 1,” “Brace No. 2.”

****Points Available for Reserve**** *The Curly-Coated Retriever Club of America will award at its National Specialty a three-point major to Reserve Winners Dog/Bitch if the Regular Class entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.*

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE:

The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
