All Regular Classes are divided by sex and are offered for all breeds or varieties of breeds unless otherwise listed below. Where classes are further divided by color, weight, or other breed characteristics, it is so indicated below and the class division MUST be indicated on the entry form.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Amateur-Owner-Handler: (AOH Class Eligibility) For dogs that are at least six (6) months of age on the first day of the show, that are not champions of record. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

Bred-By-Exhibitor Class eligibility: (BBE Class Eligibility) All dogs entered in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with AKC. For dogs that are at least six (6) months of age on the first day of the show, that are not champions of record. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. The Person handling the dog must be the person individually registered with American Kennel Club and are owned or co-owned by any of the breeders as of the date of closing entries for this show. The person handling the dog in the class must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

Best of Breed: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Also, dogs that, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose records are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championship is unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date when the dog completed the requirements for a championship, according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until his championship has been confirmed by AKC.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

The first place Winner of each of these classes, if undefeated in the show, is eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Under "AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows," Chapter 11, Section 8, Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in these classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. This is an independent specialty.

Veteran Classes

8 years & under 10 years 10 years & under 12 years 12 years & over
(Divided Dogs & Bitches)

Herding Titled Class (Divided Dogs & Bitches)

This class is offered to honor those dogs and bitches who have distinguished themselves in the job for which the Belgian Tervuren was bred. Dogs and bitches are eligible to compete if they have one or more AKC herding titles (HT, PT, HS, HSAd, HSAc, HSBd, HSBs, HSCs, HI, HIAd, HIAc, HIBd, HIBs, HIBc, HICs, HX, HXAd, HXAs, HXAc, HBXd, HBXs, HBXc, HXCc, HC) by the close of entries. The Instinct Test (IT) title does not meet the eligibility requirements of this class.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dog and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed/ Variety Competition or may be entered in Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Stud only to be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy or the standard of the breed.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as above except Substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Offspring for Get.

AKC rules Applying to Dog shows, Chapter 11, Section 8, provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and spayed bitches may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class: Effective January 1, 2005. A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for "Additional Class" "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace unit must be so designated "Brace # 1 ", "Brace # 2", etc. if entering online PLEASE CONTACT info@raudogshows.com with the Club Name, AKC Registered Names and AKC #'s of the dogs to be paired in a Brace.

Grand Champion Points: Grand Championship points will be awarded to: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch.

Judge's Award of Merit: Immediately following the Best of Breed competition, the judge may select, at her discretion, up to 10 % of the superior quality specimens from the intersex competition. These would not include those exhibits previously awarded Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog/Bitch or Best of Winners.

3 Point Major Reserve: At the National Specialty, dogs designated Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held.

SWEEPSTAKES

The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Belgian Tervuren, six (6) months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. ALL SWEEP STAKES ENTRANTS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR BREED CLASS. Entry fee is in addition to the regular class entry fee. Entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for the Regular classes. The sweepstakes class should be entered in the Additional Class field with the age division noted on the same entry used to enter the dog or bitch in the regular class. Entry Fee: \$25

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Judge: Andrea Debbins

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Belgian Tervuren, eight (8) years of age and older on the date of the show. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in a Regular Breed Class. If this is the only class in which the dog is entered, indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" with the age division noted in the Dog Show Class field. If it is an additional class, indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" with the age division noted in the Additional Class field. Entry Fee: \$25

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. However, sweepstakes winners do not go on to further placement in the shows as a result of participating in Veteran Sweepstakes.

WORKING SWEEPSTAKES

Judge: Andrea Debbins

Dogs shown in Working Sweepstakes DO NOT have to be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. Indicate Working Sweepstakes, with the division, in the Additional Class field. Spayed bitches and neutered dogs are eligible to enter. Entry fee \$25.

To be eligible for Working Sweepstakes, your dog must have titles from 2 different sport categories associated with the ABTC Versatile Tervuren program (Obedience/Rally, Agility, Herding, & Tracking/Scent Work), with one of them being higher than the Entry Level as noted below. EXCEPTION: Dogs with titles in the Working CH column do NOT require a second sport title.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Competition must exist for Best Junior Handler.

POLICY ON STANDARD OF BEHAVIOR BY ABTC MEMBERS ATTENDING SPECIALTIES

The ABTC has an excellent history of maintaining its Specialty show site in good condition. Rings, grooming areas and hotel rooms occupied by its members are expected to be left with no appreciable damage, and as clean as possible, after the specialty show is over. As a measure of insuring that this standard will be met, the club, as a matter of policy sets for the following standards of behavior.

1. No dogs should be left uncrated in a hotel room in the absence of the room occupants at any time.
2. Dogs that constitute a nuisance to other occupants of the hotel by continual barking or howling, may subject their owners to being removed by the hotel.
3. There will be no grooming of dogs in the hotel rooms. Grooming will be permitted only in the areas set aside for that purpose.
4. No Dogs should be washed in hotel bathtubs and hotel towels should not be used on dogs for drying them or any other purpose.
5. The external and internal premises of the hotel and show site shall be kept free of debris and feces caused by the presence of dogs attending the Specialty.
6. The Club will provide a committee to inspect rooms upon member checkout, either separately from, or in concert with, designated members from the hotel staff. Should any room or its contents exhibit signs of unusual wear or damage because of the presence of a dog or dogs, the occupant of that room may be held up to censure by the Club and shall recompense the hotel for all damages. Offenders may be censured, held in suspension of membership or expelled from membership in the ABTC should the circumstances warrant.
7. While the ABTC cannot assume legal responsibility for the actions of individual persons attending one of its national specialties, it does assume ethical responsibility for their actions. It will make every effort to assure that any offending person make redress to the hotel or show site in the event that he/she is responsible for damage to the premises.
8. The ABTC urges its members to carefully inspect their rooms prior to checkout.

All members of the ABTC are expected to adhere to these Standards.

The Specialty Committee additionally requires that:

1. Exhibitors are not to bring litters of puppies to Show Headquarters.
2. Non-ABTC members attending the 2024 National Specialty will adhere to these standards.
3. All dogs will be on a leash at all times.

By exhibiting at the National Specialty, you are agreeing to abide by the rules established by the show committee and the host hotel. Failure to follow these rules will result in removal from the host hotel.

ABTC DISCLAIMER & NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- There will be NO Grooming Tents provided.
- Space is not provided for unentered dogs!
- The Show Site is Handicapped Accessible.
- No Admission fee for spectators.
- No Charge for parking
- The American Belgian Tervuren Club, Inc. (ABTC) will assume NO responsibility for any personal injury or death to any person, theft, damage or loss of neither personal property, nor injury or death to any animal at or on the show grounds.
- The American Belgian Tervuren Club, Inc. reserves the right to bar participation in its National Specialty Show to any individual in debt to ABTC as well as to any individual who has failed to pay a ABTC National Specialty Show photography, videographer, hotel, or similar vendor, absent proof of a bona fide dispute with same. ABTC's ability to contract with these entities in the future mandates that all of our members, as well as non-members, pay debts that they have incurred in conjunction with ABTC's National Specialty Shows.
- The American Belgian Tervuren Club, Inc. will not allow any aggression reinstatement procedures to be performed during this Specialty. No dogs that are currently disqualified by AKC for aggression will be allowed to enter this event, nor be allowed on the show grounds.
- The American Belgian Tervuren Club, Inc. does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

THE CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All Trophies must be claimed the day of the show - none will be mailed.

ALL EXHIBITORS are asked to remove all dogs and items from the arena immediately upon completion of BOB judging on Saturday 6/15/24.

NO DOGS will be allowed to remain in the Roberts Centre overnight.

CRATING & GROOMING: Grooming and crating in designated areas only. Bathing of dogs limited to bathing area, located next to grooming area. No dogs allowed in bathrooms.

NO Ringside Crating in the Convention Centre - with the exception of the Obedience and Rally Trials.

PARKING: Exhibitor and visitor parking will be in parking lots in rear of Holiday Inn. Vehicles are limited to one parking space. No Ex-pens or Crates allowed on blacktop, but are allowed in indicated grass areas.

No cones allowed in parking areas. **NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED NEXT TO BUILDING OR IN ANY ROADWAY. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.**

ABTC, ROBERTS Centre, THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT and their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or spectators, their family, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury for children.

NO ONE IS PERMITTED anywhere that is marked "Employees Only" and/or "No admittance."

NO FIREARMS allowed in Roberts Centre.

ANY DAMAGES to motels by exhibitors can result in disciplinary action by a Show Committee due to numerous events in the area, please make your motel reservation early.

DOGS FOUND IN AN UNSAFE ENVIRONMENT, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment.
