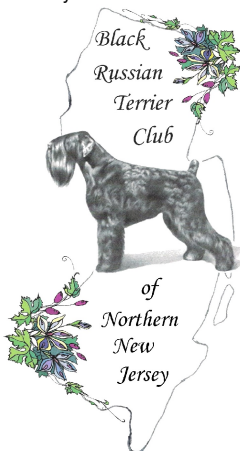

### Bred-by-Exhibitor (BBE) Class eligibility

- All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC.
- The persons handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

### Amateur-Owner-Handler

For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler.

### Award of Merits

At the discretion of the judge may award based on the number of dogs entered in Best of Breed Competition will be: 2-10 Entries - 1 Award, 11-20 Entries - 2 Awards, 21-30 Entries - 3 Awards.

## DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

**From Route 1 Southbound** - Take Route 1 Exit. Exit onto Main Street and go 1/4 mile to the traffic light onto Route 514 East (Woodbridge Avenue). Turn right at the Sheraton Hotel into Raritan Center. Follow the signs to the Expo Center.

**From Route 1 Northbound** - After crossing the Raritan River Bridge, get into the right lane. After passing "Open Round Honda" take the third right hand exit onto Route 514 East (Woodbridge Avenue). Follow Woodbridge Avenue for 3 to 4 miles. Make a right at the Sheraton Hotel into Raritan Center. Follow the signs to the Expo Center.

**From Route I-287 South** - Follow Route I-287 South to the Bonhamtown ONLY, Route 514 West Exit. (This exit is just after the NJ Turnpike Exit). Follow Route 514 West to the first exit ramp marked Raritan Center. Follow the signs to the Expo Center.

**From the NJ Turnpike** - Follow the NJ Turnpike to Exit 10. Pay the toll, to the right, follow Route 514 West to Raritan Center. Take the first exit marked Raritan Center and follow the signs to the Expo Center.

**From the Garden State Parkway Southbound** - Follow the Parkway to Exit 129. Take Route I-287 North to Route 514 West to the first exit marked Raritan Center and follow the signs to the Expo Center.

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
