NON-RVs MAY NOT PLUG INTO OUTDOOR ELECTRIC - If found, you will be directed to move, or, you will be charged for RV PARKING AT \$72 PER DAY, decision to be made by Site Control Staff.

NON-RVs WISHING TO PARK OVERNIGHT on Farm Show property, (even without electric), **MUST PAY AS AN RV AT A CHARGE OF \$72 PER NIGHT.**

RV PARKING (see RV Parking Reservation Form)

-Reserved: \$62 per night; If not reserving: \$72 per night upon arrival

SPECTATOR PARKING

UNLOADING/LOADING

Follow directions of Site Control staff. Keep headlights on while unloading/loading.

All vehicles must be removed from the unloading/loading area immediately after unloading/loading.

SET-UP

Set-up of indoor grooming/cratering is Tuesday, 4:00 PM until 10:00 PM.

No entry before 4:00 PM on Tuesday.

ALL PERSONS MUST BE OUT OF BUILDING BY 10:00 PM.

FREE All-Breed Indoor Grooming/Cratering available, first come-first served. No saving of space.

OPTIONAL - RESERVED INDOOR GROOMING/CRATERING - see Reservation Form

For the convenience of not having to rush in on set-up day, "Optional" paid/reserved areas are available.

-Deadline to reserve is MARCH 27, 2024 - See Reservation Form for details.

-Electric is a separate fee and will be collected at show. DO NOT pre-pay.

ATTENTION SPECIALTY CLUBS

FREE reserved grooming/cratering areas will be designated for SPECIALTIES. Only SPECIALTY BREEDS may set up in these designated areas. Space is determined based on entries. No need to pay for Optional Reserved Grooming/Cratering space. Electric is NOT free. You will need to purchase electric upon your arrival.

DAY GROOMING/CRATERING

A limited amount of space will be available for DAY CRATERING. **All equipment must be removed from this area by the conclusion of Best in Show each day.** Anything left in this space will be removed by the Event Committee.

DOGS IN BUILDING OVERNIGHT

Dogs MAY be left in the building overnight, however there is NO admittance to the building between 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM. Please put crate tags on crates with contact information in case of emergency. A guard will be on duty in the building overnight, however neither the Farm Show Complex, nor the show giving clubs or anyone associated with the events are responsible for any animals or equipment left in the building.

INDOOR ELECTRIC - \$100 for Entire Cluster (5 show days)

FROM PITTSBURGH AND WEST VIA THE PA TURNPIKE - Travel East on the Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 242. Take I-83 North to 2nd Street Exit (Exit 43). At first traffic light at bottom of ramp, turn right onto Paxton Street. At next traffic light (car dealer on left, restaurant on right), turn left onto Cameron Street. (PA Rt 230). Follow Cameron Street approximately 1.9 miles, crossing over Maclay Street to Farm Show Parking lot on left.

FROM PHILADELPHIA AND EAST VIA THE PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE - Travel West on the Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 247. Follow I-283 North toward Harrisburg. Take I-83 North to Rt. 81 SOUTH. Travel I-81 South to Cameron Street (PA Rt. 230) Exit 67 (East) to Farm Show on right.

VIA ROUTE 81 (NORTH AND SOUTH) - Rt. I-81 to Cameron Street (PA Rt. 230) Exit 67 (East) to Farm Show on right.

VIA ROUTE 15 SOUTHBOUND (NORTH OF HARRISBURG) - Travel Route 15 South to Route 322 East. Follow Route 322 East to Cameron Street (PA RT. 230) Exit. Follow Cameron Street to Farm Show Building.

VIA ROUTE 15 NORTHBOUND (SOUTH OF HARRISBURG) - Travel Route 15 North. Exit at Rt. 581 East. Follow Rt. 581 as it merges into I-83 North. After crossing the Susquehanna River, take the 2nd Street Exit (Exit 43). At first traffic light at bottom of ramp, turn right onto Paxton Street. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
