NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

Both Days

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. **A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

AKC SANCTIONED 4 & UNDER 6 MONTHS PUPPY COMPETITION

Saturday Only

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are four months and under six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. There will be a selection of Best of Breed Puppy in each Breed/Variety. All Best of Breed Puppy winners will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth. RAMP INFO

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: AMERICAN WATER SPANIEL; BOYKIN SPANIEL; ENGLISH SPRINGER SPANIEL; FIELD SPANIEL; NS DUCK TOLLING RETRIEVER; WELSH SPRINGER SPANIEL; GRAND BASSET GRIFFON VENDEEN; WHIPPET; GERMAN PINSCHER; STANDARD SCHNAUZERS; AMERICAN STAFFORDSHIRE; IRISH TERRIERS; MINI BULL TERRIER (Ground/Table); SOFT COATED WHEATEN TERRIER; STAFFORDSHIRE BULL TERRIER; FINNISH SPITZ; AUSTRALIAN CATTLE DOG; ENTLEBUCHER MOUNTAIN DOG; FINNISH LAPPHUND; ICELANDIC SHEEPDOGS; MUDI (or Table); NORWEGIAN BUHUND; POLISH LOWLAND SHEEPDOG; PULI (or Table); SPANISH WATER DOG; BASSET FAUVE DE BRETAGNE (Misc.); NORRBOTTENSPEETS (Misc.)

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: CLUMBER SPANIEL; LAGOTTO ROMAGNOLO; SUSSEX SPANIEL; BASSET HOUND; CIRNECO DELL'ETNA; KERRY BLUE TERRIER; BULLDOGS; CHINESE SHAR-PEI; CHOW CHOW; KEESHONDEN;

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breed.

Airedale Terriers & English Cocker Spaniels - Saturday Only

Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class - A class with the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch and two (2) of their get/produce. Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be entered on the regular form as an additional class. Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be shown in the ring with their get/produce. Owner of Stud Dog/Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the get. Judging of this class will be after the Best of Breed Class. Entry Fee: \$26.00.

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever - Saturday

Hunting Retriever - A Class for Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Dogs/Bitches that have a Working Certificate Excellent (WCX) from the NSDTRC (USA) or an AKC Senior Hunter title (SH), Master Hunter title (MH) or Master Hunter Upland title (MHU). This is a single dog entry class, eligible for Best of Breed (if otherwise undefeated). Dogs must be intact--no spayed or neutered dogs are allowed. The Hunting Retriever class shall be divided by sex.

Working Retriever - A Class for Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Dogs/Bitches that have a Working Certificate (WC), Working Certificate Intermediate (WCI), AKC Junior Hunter Title (JH), Junior Hunter Upland Title (JHU) or Senior Hunter Upland Title (SHU). This is a single dog entry class, eligible for Best of Breed (if otherwise undefeated). Dogs must be intact--no spayed or neutered dogs are allowed. The Working Retriever class shall be divided by sex, and is for any dog that has earned an NSDTRC(USA) WC or WCI, or AKC JH title or higher. Dogs eligible to enter the Hunting Retriever Class may also enter the Working Retriever Class. The winners of Working Retriever Dog, Working Retriever Bitch, Hunting Retriever Dog and Hunting Retriever Bitch classes would all go on to compete for Best of Breed if still undefeated, similar to the way the veterans class is split by age. Divided by sex.

Veterans - 7 years and under 9 years; 9 years and under 11; 11 years and over. Divided by sex.

Borzoi, Scottish Deerhounds & Cardigan Welsh Corgi - Saturday & Sunday

Airedale Terriers & English Cocker Spaniels - Saturday Only

Veteran Class - Open to Dogs and Bitches 7 years old or older. Eligible for Best of Breed. Veterans MAY NOT be neutered or spayed for these breeds.

- Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show.
- Individually registered with the AKC as of the date of closing of entries for the show.
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show.
- The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
