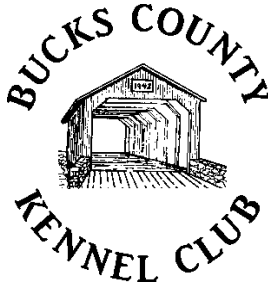

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW GROUNDS

From North & South Via Interstate 295: Take 295 to Exit 65A, Sloane Avenue. East on Sloane Avenue to Second traffic light, Quaker Bridge Road. Cross over Quaker Bridge Road and go to next traffic light (road makes a T) and make a left onto Edinburg Road (Route 535). The name of the road changes to Old Trenton Road. Continue for about 2 miles with Mercer County Park ENTRANCE on the left.

From North Via U.S. 1: Take US 1 South of Princeton to Rt. 533, Quakerbridge Road. Bear Right off US 1 onto jug handle to cross over US 1 onto Rt. 533, Quakerbridge Road. Go to the 6th traffic light and turn left onto Hughes Drive. At the first traffic light, turn left into Mercer County Park. Follow road to event staff for parking instructions.

From South Via U.S. Route 1: Cross toll bridge into New Jersey. On U.S. 1 make first right past Quakerbridge Mall onto Quakerbridge Road (Route 533). Go to the 6th traffic light and turn left onto Hughes Drive. At the first traffic light turn left into Mercer County Park. Follow road to event staff for parking instructions.

From North (Route 130 South) or NJ Turnpike Exit 8 A: Exit 8A toward Rt. 130 South. Go to the 6th light on Route 130 South and turn right onto Old Trenton Road (Rt. 535). Go through 6 traffic lights and Mercer County Park ENTRANCE is on the right.

From South Via NJ Route 130/206: Follow Route 130 North to Route 526 in Robbinsville and turn left on to Route 526. (Corners: Costal Delta Station, Russert's Deli, Taco Bell). Turn right at the next traffic light; you are still on Route 526 with Rite Aide on your right. From this point travel 3 miles to Route 535, Old Trenton Road and turn left. The exhibitors's ENTRANCE is 1/3 mile ahead on the right.

From South Via New Jersey Turnpike: Take NJ Turnpike North to Exit 7A. Take Interstate 195 West to Exit 5B which is the first exit on Route 195 To Route 130 North/New Brunswick. Travel North on Route 130 to second traffic light and turn left onto Route 526. Proceed to the next traffic light and right onto Route 526 with Rite Aide on your right. Go 3 miles to Route 526, Old Trenton Road. Mercer County Park ENTRANCE is 1/3 mile on the right.

Any exhibitor who allows his/her dogs to be loose and unattended in a room orto do damage to hotel property and who then does not immediately contact the hotel management to make proper restitution, will be subject to Event Committee action which could result in the loss of AKC privileges. This also applies to cleaning up after your dog at the hotel/motel grounds

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

This is a Condensed Premium List as authorized by the American Kennel Club, "Rules Applying to Dog Shows", Chapter 6, Section 2A. A complete list of trophies and prizes is available upon request to the Superintendent. Trophy donors will be listed in the catalog.

Obedience classes are open to All-American dogs in the Canine Partners Program.

Pop-up Tents, Crates, Grooming Tables, Ex-Pens, Reserved Parking, RV parking, Unloading etc., and any other accommodation deemed necessary for a safe event, as designated by the show committee in specified areas only.

Unentered dogs are not permitted on the Show Grounds. Bucks County Kennel Club, Inc. and the Bucks County Parks Department will not permit reinstatement examinations of dogs previously disqualified. All dogs must have updated rabies certificates and must present them upon request of Event Committee or Park Service Employee.

The Club and its Superintendent caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved.

RAMP INFO

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: AMERICAN WATER SPANIEL, BOYKIN SPANIEL, ENGLISH SPRINGER SPANIEL, FIELD SPANIEL, LAGOTTO ROMAGNOLO, NS DUCK TOLLING RETRIEVER, WELSH SPRINGER SPANIEL, GRAND BASSET GRIFFON VENDEEN, WHIPPET (Ground/Table thru 3/28/23), GERMAN PINSCHER, STANDARD SCHNAUZERS, AMERICAN STAFFORDSHIRE, IRISH TERRIERS, MINI BULL TERRIER (Ground/Table), SOFT COATED WHEATEN TERRIER, STAFFORDSHIRE BULL TERRIER, FINNISH SPITZ, ENTLEBUCHER MOUNTAIN DOG, FINNISH LAPPHUND, ICELANDIC SHEEPDOGS, MUDI (or Table), NORWEGIAN BUHUND, POLISH LOWLAND SHEEPDOG, SPANISH WATER DOG, NORRBOTTENSPETS (Misc.)

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: CLUMBER SPANIEL, SUSSEX SPANIEL, BASSET HOUND, CIRNECO DELL'ETNA, KERRY BLUE TERRIER, BULLDOGS, CHINESE SHAR-PEI, CHOW CHOW, KEESHONDEN

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breed.

PUBLICATION RIGHTS: By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

All Regular Classes are divided by sex and are offered for all breeds or varieties of breeds unless otherwise listed below. Where classes are further divided by color, weight, or other breed characteristics, it is so indicated below and the class division MUST be indicated on the entry form.

Non-Regular Classes

Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Classes - Where offered - see breed details. Class for dogs and class for bitches 7 years & over. Must be intact. Eligible for BOB.

Veteran Classes - POINTERS & RHODESIAN

RIDGEBACKS ONLY - Classes for dogs and class for bitches 7 years & under 9 years, 9 years & under 11 years & 11 years & over.

Veteran Classes - BASSET HOUNDS ONLY - For dogs and bitches that are seven (7) years old or older on the date of the show. To be eligible for this class, dogs must be intact.

Veteran Classes - IRISH SETTERS ONLY - Class for dogs and class for bitches 8 years & over.

Veteran Classes - MASTIFFS ONLY - Classes for dogs and class for bitches 6 years & under 8 years; 8 years & under 10 years & 10 years & over.

Hunting Dog Classes - POINTERS ONLY - Class for dogs and class for bitches who have earned their Hunting Dog Title; either Junior, Senior or Master Hunter title.

Field Trial Classes - POINTERS ONLY - Class for dogs and class for bitches who have placed in an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial.

Field Trial Classes -BASSET HOUNDS ONLY Class for dogs & class bitches that have placed first through fourth in an AKC Licensed Field Trial or who has an AKC Field Trial Championship. To be eligible for this class, dogs must be intact."

Hunting Retriever Started Class - FLAT-COATED RETRIEVERS ONLY - Class for dogs and class for bitches with a Working Certificate (WC), a Junior Hunter (JH) Title, or a Junior Hunter Upland (JHU) title.

Hunting Retriever Intermediate Class - FLAT-COATED RETRIEVERS ONLY - Class for dogs and class for bitches with a Working Certificate Excellent (WCX), a Senior Hunter (SH) title, a Senior Hunter Upland (SHU) title, or Derby Placements or Judges Award of Merits (JAM).

Hunting Retriever Finished Class - FLAT-COATED RETRIEVERS ONLY - Class for dogs and class for bitches with a Master Hunter (MH) title, a Master Hunter Upland (MHU) title, Qualifying and/or All Age placements or Judges Award of Merits (JAM), a Field Champion (FC) title or Amateur Field Champion (AFC) title.

Best of Breed Competition

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class - Where indicated, will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its breed. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes.

Brood Bitch Class - Where Indicated - The same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog & Produce for Get.

Brace Class - Where indicated - Two dogs of the same breed or variety, must have at least one common owner & presented by a maximum of two handlers. Dogs may be entered for Brace Competition. Dogs competing in the Brace Class must be entered in a Regular or Non-Regular Class. Brace Class must be noted on the entry form in the space for "Additional Classes." If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC Owner/Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners who are not professional handlers. This series of special competitions will be offered at dog shows across the country.

All dogs that are owner/handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers' meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner/Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the competition by an eligible owner. Professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any competition during the entire show.**

The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled Group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition ineligible and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible undefeated exhibits of the owner sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are both ineligible and Select Dog and Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all dogs of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are ineligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners Competition.

AKC SANCTIONED 4 & UNDER 6 MONTHS PUPPY COMPETITION

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are four months and under six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. There will be a selection of Best of Breed Puppy in each Breed/Variety. All Best of Breed Puppy winners will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth.

The Miscellaneous class competition will be judged by breed followed by a group competition. Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds may compete and the winners of each FSS breed will compete in an "FSS Group". The Miscellaneous Group an FSS Group winners will be eligible to compete in Best 4-6 Month Puppy in Show. An AKC registration number or litter number is required for entries of an AKC recognized breed. FSS number or FSS registered litter number is required for Miscellaneous & FSS Breed entries.

Dogs must be four months of age and under six months. Dogs are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized. AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4-6 month Puppy Special Attraction event.

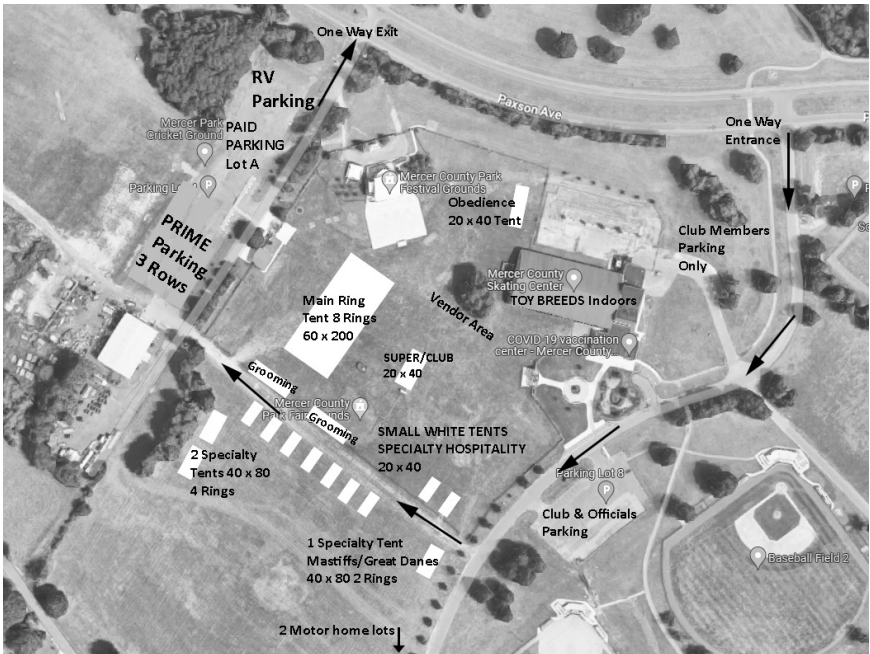

THE SHOW will be open from 7AM - 7PM

AN AKC RECORDING FEE OF 50¢ & an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee & Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check.

TELEGRAPH, and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO JIM RAU DOG SHOWS, LTD. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. The Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2006 an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.)
