DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW GROUNDS

- From North & South Via Interstate 295: Take 295 to Exit 65A, Sloane Avenue. East on Sloane Avenue to Second traffic light, Quaker Bridge Road. Cross over Quaker Bridge Road and go to next traffic light (road makes a T) and make a left onto Edinburg Road (Route 535). The name of the road changes to Old Trenton Road. Continue for about 2 miles with Mercer County Park ENTRANCE on the left.
 From North Via U.S. 1: Take US 1 South of Princeton to Rt. 533, Quakerbridge Road. Bear Right off US 1 onto jug handle to cross over US 1 onto Rt. 533, Quakerbridge Road. Go to the 6th traffic lightand turn left onto Hughes Drive. At the first traffic light, turn left into Mercer County Park. Follow road to event staff for parking instructions
- for parking instructions.
- From South Via U.S. Route 1: Cross toll bridge into New Jersey. On U.S. 1 make first right past Quakerbridge Mall onto Quakerbridge Road (Route 533). Go to the 6th traffic light and turn left onto Hughes Drive. At the first traffic light turn left into Mercer County Park. Follow road to event staff for parking instructions.
- From North (Route 130 South) or NJ Turnpike Exit 8 A: Exit 8A toward Rt. 130 South. Go to the 6th light on Route 130 South and turn right onto Old Trenton Road (Rt. 535). Go through 6 traffic lights and Mercer
- From South Via NJ Route 130/206: Follow Route 130 North to Route 526 in Robbinsville and turn left on to Route 526. (Corners: Costal Delta Station, Russert's Deli, Taco Bell). Turn right at the next traffic light; you are still on Route 526 with Rite Aide on your right. From this point travel 3 miles to Route 535, Old Trenton Road and turn left. The exhibitors's ENTRANCE is 1/3 mile ahead on the right.
- From South Via New Jersey Turnpike: Take NJ Turnpike Noth to Exit 7A. Take Interstate 195 West to Exit 5B which is the first exit on Route 195 To Route 130 North/New Brunswick. Travel North on Route 130 to second traffic light and turn left onto Route 526. Proceed to the next traffic light andright onto Route 526 with Rite Aide on your right. Go 3 miles to Route 526, Old Trenton Road. Mercer County Park ENTRANCE is 1/3 mile on the right.



RAMP INFO

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

The following breeds must be judged on a Ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner Handled eligible at the time of entry on the series of the dedication of the series of the se owner-handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

AKC SANCTIONED 4 & UNDER 6 MONTHS PUPPY COMPETITION

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are four months and under six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. Dryland Races Rules All races both snow and dry land must be under the direction of a Recognized Race Giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A Race Season is from April 1 to March 31 of the following year.
 b. Entries who complete five (5) years in competition where the above rules are met shall be automatically qualified for the Sled Dog Class. A certificate of proof may be issued by the Chair of the Working Committee if the 5 years of proof of competition records are sent in.
 c. Entries who have been awarded an SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either SD, SDX or SDO and are additionally eligible for entry in a conformation class at an AKC event, are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog Class.
- Spayed or neutered dogs are not exhibited in the Sled Dog Class as required by the American Kennel Club.

A list of the races in which the dog competed, or a copy of the five year certificate or a copy of the Sled Dog Degree must be sent to the Show Secretary when entry is made. Proof of qualification must be available at ringside with one of these shown if challenged.

The Show Secretary shall request the following be provided with each entry to the Sled Dog Class: Each dog's AKC Registered Name, AKC Registered Number, Sex, Race and Date of Race, miles per heat and total miles --or a five (5) year proof certificate--or copy of the Sled Dog Degree.

Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
