Overnight parking will be available on a "first-come-first-served" basis after 3:00 pm Friday, May 10, 2024. No one will be parked on the show grounds prior to that time. All recreational vehicles must be self-contained. There will be no electric, water or sewer hookups available.

#### **★ NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ★**

- JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
