Bred-by-Exhibitor Class eligibility: All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The Person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Amateur-Owner-Handler - For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, any any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler (effective January 1, 2009) (Optional class).

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Single Dog Entries)

Veteran Dog Classes For dogs 9 yrs & under 11 yrs; 11 yrs and under 13 yrs, 13 yrs and over.

Veteran Bitch Classes Same as for Dogs

Sled Dog Classes: Non-Degreed; SD; SDX/SDO

1. Entry must be an American Kennel Club or Canadian Kennel Club registered Siberian Husky (eligible under chapter 15, Sec. 1 of the AKC Rules regarding Registration & Dog Shows).
2. There will be a class for dogs and a class for bitches. At the discretion of Show Chair additional classes may be offered based on the requirements of the Sled Dog Degree Program.
3. If entered in a class for which full entry fee was paid, no additional fee will be required to also exhibit in the sled dog class. If not, the entry fee to exhibit solely in Sled Dog will be a regular entry fee.
4. To qualify for entry in the Sled Dog Class, the dog must have completed one of the following three requirements:
 - a. During the previous racing season, the applicant must have completed ten (10) heats with a minimum of four (4) miles per heat on snow or 3.5 miles per heat with rigs on dry land, or the total miles per season not being less than forty-eight (48) miles. The 48 miles can consist of a combination of both snow and dry land races. All races must be under the direction of a Recognized Race Giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A Race Season is from April 1 to March 31 of the following year.
 - b. Entries who complete five (5) years in competition where the above rules are met shall be automatically qualified for the Sled Dog Class. A certificate of proof may be issued by the Chair of the Working Committee if the 5 years of proof of competition records are sent in.
 - c. Entries who have been awarded an SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either SD, SDX or SDO and are additionally eligible for entry in a conformation class at an AKC event, are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog Class.
5. Spayed or neutered dogs are not exhibited in the Sled Dog Class as required by the American Kennel Club.

A list of the races in which the dog competed, or a copy of the five year certificate or a copy of the Sled Dog Degree must be sent to the Show Secretary when entry is made. Proof of qualification must be available at ringside with one of these shown if challenged.

The Show Secretary shall request the following be provided with each entry to the Sled Dog Class: Each dog's AKC Registered Name, AKC Registered Number, Sex, Race and Date of Race, miles per heat and total miles --or a five (5) year proof certificate--or copy of the Sled Dog Degree.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of Get. Get only to be Judged, based on merits of the Get. Entry fee \$25.00 total for Stud Dog and two Get as a First Entry. An entry fee of \$20.00 will be charged for Stud Dog and two Get as an additional entry.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as above except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class - a brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising the Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only", fee \$25.00 per dog. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes - "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated - "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. Brace as an additional class \$20.00 (unit).

TWO OBEDIENCE TRIALS

(Open to Siberian Huskies Only)

A **Qualifying Score** is required for all prizes in the Regular Classes.

"Dog" means either sex.

BITCHES IN SEASON. Since bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience/Rally Trials, all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason, will be refunded. To be eligible for such refund the Show Secretary must be notified by letter postmarked March 3, 2024 or earlier, together with a veterinarian's certificate confirming the fact that the bitch is in season.

A **Dark Green Qualifying Score Ribbon** will be awarded to all dogs attaining a qualifying score in the Regular Classes.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES SATURDAY & SUNDAY MARCH 2-3, 2024

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. **A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club - PHONE: (919) 233-9767.

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to entry the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Competition must exist for Best Junior Handler.

JUNIORS WITH A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW WHO SUBSTITUTE A DOG NOT ENTERED IN THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JUNIOR ONLY AND JUNIOR AS AN ADDITIONAL CLASS ENTRY FEE. Children between 5 years to under 9 years can join the fun of dog showing. This attraction is offered to inspire young handlers to love and show their dogs. This event is for "exhibition only" and there will be no placements of the entries. All children will receive the same participation award from the judge. Dogs are to be AKC recognized breed and at least 4 months old. Children enter the ring with their dog one at a time. Additional entry forms will be made available at the club table for day-of entry. Release forms must be signed day-of prior to participating. For more information contact the CSHC. Entry Fee is Free.

Prior to the beginning of the class, the responsible adult will sign a **RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM**. Check-in or enter at the club table
Each child will receive a Gift Bag

- Child must be between the ages of five and nine years old.
- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee Class
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. if pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- Siberian Huskies only
- The AKC registered pure bred dogs must be registered to participate.
- A release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. This release will be available on site and must be signed before going into the ring.

The safety of both the dogs and children inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child.

An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

EXHIBITORS MUST BE GOVERNED by the rules or regulations of park and civil authorities and/or building or location restrictions.

EXHIBITORS WILL BE REQUIRED to keep the grounds clean and sanitary at all times, and to place refuse in the containers provided.

- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list, if the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. - Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
