BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Dogs, 7 Years & Under 9 Years
Dogs, 9 Years & Over
(Same Classes for Bitches)

Under "AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows," Chapter 11, Section 8, Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. This is an independent specialty.

Gundog Class: This class is open only to those dogs/bitches that have received a title in AKC Hunt tests. Entries may be spayed or neutered. Winners (if undefeated) are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries (National Specialty ONLY)

Stud Dog: For Stud Dog and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed/Variety Competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition.

Brood Bitch: Same as above for Stud Dog except Substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace: A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers.) Both dogs must be entered in another class. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dog comprising each Brace must be so designated, "Brace # 1," "Brace # 2" etc.

Additional Eligibility & Awards

Best Puppy (National Only): During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Puppy Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. Dogs & Bitches in the 6-9 Months, 9-12 Months and Puppy Bred-By-Exhibitor will compete for Best Puppy.

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor class are eligible for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. The Dogs & Bitches in Bred-By-Exhibitor (Puppy) & Bred-By-Exhibitor (Adult) will compete for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor.

Best Veteran Competition (National Only): During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran from the Veteran Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Veteran class is awarded Best of Winner or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Veteran class are eligible for Best Veteran competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. Neutered and spayed dogs and bitches may compete.

Grand Champion Points: Grand Championship points will be awarded to: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch.

3 Point Major Reserve (National Only): At the National Specialty, dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held.

Judge's Award of Merit: Immediately following the Best of Breed competition, the judge may select, at his discretion, up to 4 of the superior quality specimens from the intersex competition (up to two of each sex). These would not include those exhibits previously awarded Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog/Bitch or Best of Winners.

SWEEPSTAKES

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Clumber Spaniels six (6) months of age and under 24 months of age on the day of the show. **ALL SWEEPSTAKES ENTRANTS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR BREED CLASS.** Entries shall be made at the same time, and on the same entry form as for the Regular classes. The sweepstakes class should be entered in the Additional Class field with the age division noted on the same entry used to enter the dog or bitch in the regular class. **ENTRY FEE is \$30**

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Clumber Spaniels, seven (7) years of age and older on the date of the show. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes **NEED NOT** be entered in a Regular Breed Class. If this is the only class in which the dog is entered, indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" with the age division noted in the Dog Show Class field. If it is an additional class, indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" with the age division noted in the Additional Class field. **ENTRY FEE is \$30**

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. However, sweepstakes winners do not go on to further placement in the shows as a result of participating in Veteran Sweepstakes.

GUN-DOG SWEEPSTAKES

The National Gun Dog Sweepstakes is open to all Clumber Spaniels that have earned an AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter, or Master Hunter title or legs toward titles. The highest level leg or title that a dog has earned will determine the class in which it will be entered. Dogs shown in Gun Dog Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular breed class. Indicate your Gun Dog Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided. Neutered dogs & spayed bitches may be entered in Gun Dog Sweepstakes. Winners of each class will compete for Best in Gun Dog Sweepstakes & Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Gun Dog Sweepstakes. The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches. Junior Hunter - For dogs that have earned legs toward or the AKC JH Title Senior Hunter - For dogs that have earned legs toward or the AKC SH Title Master Hunter - For dogs that have earned legs towards or the AKC MH Entries shall be made at the same time on the same entry form as for "Regular Classes". Indicate "Gun Dog Sweepstakes" and class division in the space for Additional Classes". **ENTRY FEE is \$30.00**

OBEDIENCE & RALLY

The term "dog" refers to either dog or bitch in both Obedience and Rally.

Qualifying scores are required for all trophies and rosettes in the regular classes.

Non-Regular & Tilling classes are not eligible for the Special Obedience Trial trophies, nor will qualifying scores be awarded AKC legs or points towards Obedience Trial Championships.

OBEDIENCE & RALLY MOVE-UPS WILL BE ACCEPTED ACCORDING TO AKC REGULATIONS.

No bitches in season may compete. Entry fees will be refunded for females in season. A processing fee may be retained by the club. (Obedience regulations Chapter 1, Section 14).

A refund of all but \$3.00 for bitches in season upon presentation of a written statement from a veterinarian to the Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the beginning of regular class judging.

A rosette will be given to each entry receiving a qualifying score in the Regular Classes.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. **A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

AKC SANCTIONED 4 & UNDER 6 MONTHS PUPPY COMPETITION

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are four months and under six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. There will be a selection of Best of Breed Puppy in each Breed/Variety. All Best of Breed Puppy winners will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth. Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Competition must exist for Best Junior Handler.

JUNIORS WITH A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW WHO SUBSTITUTE A DOG NOT ENTERED IN THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JUNIOR ONLY AND JUNIOR AS AN ADDITIONAL CLASS ENTRY FEE. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breed.

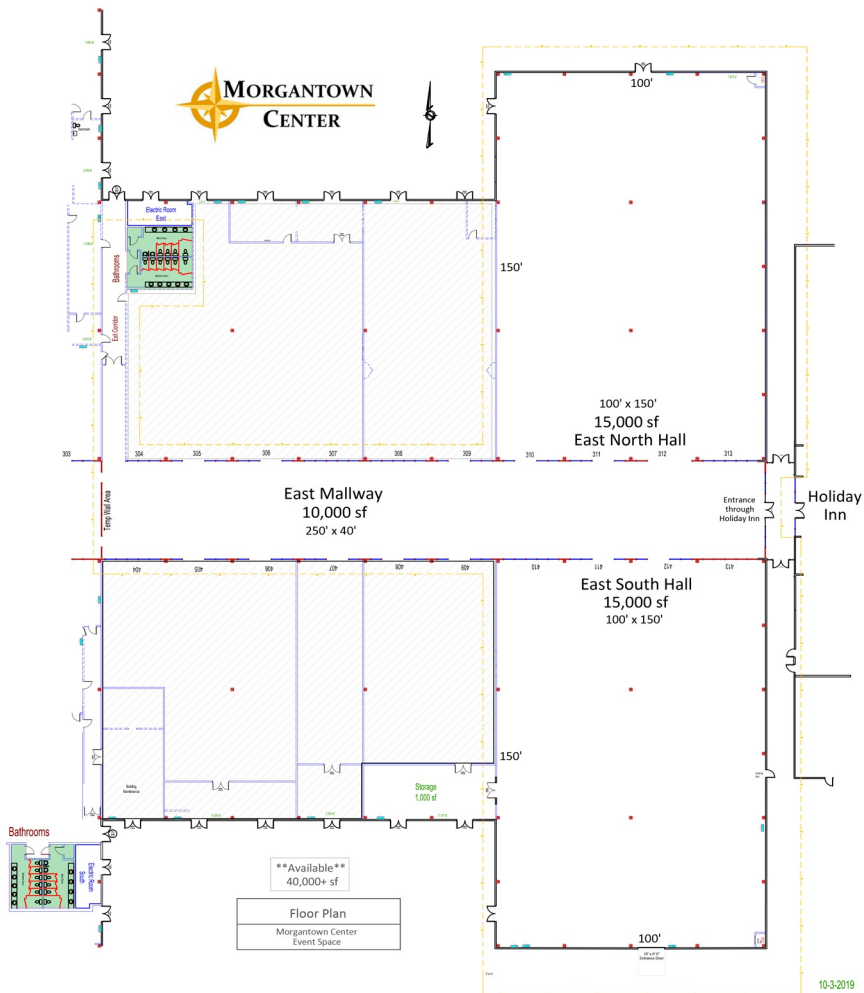

Standards for Submitting Files for Printing

Successful printing of your ad is dependent on different computers properly interpreting the files you are submitting. With this as our goal, at any time, please don't hesitate to ask questions prior to submitting files. These guidelines should help eliminate errors if they are followed.

• Send **ONLY** the file you want to print [a pdf file is preferred] and be sure it is the size of the ad you are purchasing. If there is going to be an enlargement or reduction, please make sure the ad is proportional.

The Program size is 5.5" wide x 8.5" tall. Therefore, if you submit an 8.5 x 5.5 ad which is not oriented correctly, the ad will read wrong (unless you intend it to do so). You can't make an ad designed to be landscape or "wide" be sized to fit a space that is portrait or "tall".

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
