NOTICE REGARDING TROPHIES: All trophies will be available at the Club’s Trophy Table and must be claimed prior to the awarding of Best in Show unless otherwise indicated. Any trophy which remains unclaimed by the time Best in Show is awarded will be forfeited. No trophy will be mailed.

ROSETTES FOR SUPPORTED ENTRIES: Delaware Valley Hound Association and its members are proud to offer Rosettes for the following awards for all of our Supported Breeds: *Best of Breed or Variety, Best Of Winners, Best Opposite Sex, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Owner-Handled Best of Breed.* Please refer to **PRIZES** for other rosettes that may be offered beyond the placements noted here.

ROSETTES FOR NEW TITLE HOLDERS: A rosette will be awarded to each dog that finished their championship or title at this show. Please pick up the rosette at the Club’s Trophy Table.

GROOMING SPACES: The grooming areas open to exhibitors not earlier than 2PM on Tuesday. Breeds exhibiting in Ring 10 should use grooming space in Hall E. All other conformation crating space is in Hall A. Electricity is free and available in all areas within range of a 100-foot extension cord.

Up to 140 reserved preferred spaces in Hall A and an additional 60 in Hall E are available by pre-registration. Spaces may be reserved without limit on a first come, first served basis. Each 5 x 6 ft space is \$20 by on-line order or \$25 by mail order for the entire cluster. The fee for one space per person is waived for breeds conducting **SPECIALTIES ONLY**. See separate form on p.12 of WBC premium to reserve preferred space. **EVEN IF NO FEE IS DUE, A FORM MUST BE SENT** so that a space can be reserved. The remaining free space is available on a first come, first served basis. No reserving of space in the free section will be permitted. Stacking of crates is encouraged. For further information refer to WBC Premium

OVERNIGHT CRATING: Dogs may be left overnight on Tuesday through Saturday. On the crate of each dog staying overnight must be placed a label or tag bearing the dog’s call name, owner’s or handler’s name, and owner’s or handler’s mobile phone number. **The hall will be locked not later than 10PM each night and unlocked at 6AM the following morning.** Though a security guard will be present, BCKC, SJKC, and VFKC and DVHA recommend against the use of overnight crating. BCKC, SJKC, and VFKC and DVHA will not be responsible for any injury or loss that occurs during or results from the use of overnight crating. Such use is entirely at the owner’s risk. For further information refer to WBC Premium.

RV PARKING is \$100 by online order or \$120 by mail order REGARDLESS OF DURATION and by pre-registration only. Failure to pre-register will result in an additional \$50 LATE FEE or refusal of admission to the RV parking area. See separate form on p.12 of WBC premium to reserve RV parking space. **RV parking is available at 4PM Tuesday; all rigs must depart by 7PM Sunday.** Absolutely no hook-ups available, and no electric lines may be laid across roads. Fire lanes must be kept clear. No parking spaces may be reserved using cones. Exercise pens must use wood shavings and be cleaned up before departure. A dumpster is available for waste collection. Failure to obey the instructions of parking officials will result in forfeiture of parking privileges and may result in further penalty per the Event Committee. AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)

National Owner-Handled Series The AKC Owner/Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners who are not professional handlers. This series of special competitions will be offered at dog shows across the country.

All dogs that are owner/handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers' meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner/Handler eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the competition by an eligible owner. Professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.**

The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled Group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition ineligible and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible undefeated exhibits of the owner sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are both ineligible and Select Dog and Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all dogs of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are ineligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners Competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.*

Best of Breed (Variety) Competition

All Regular Classes are divided by sex and are offered for all breeds or varieties of breeds unless otherwise noted. Where classes are further divided by color, weight, or other breed characteristics, it is so indicated, and the class division MUST be indicated on the entry form.

***Amateur-Owner-Handler** - For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler

****Bred-by-Exhibitor Class eligibility:** All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The Person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

*****SWEEPSTAKES RULES – APPLICABLE TO RHODESIAN RIDGEBACKS AT THIS SHOW:**

The Puppy Sweepstakes classes are open to Rhodesian Ridgebacks who are 6 months and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Indicate Sweepstakes and age division on the regular entry form under "Additional Classes". Entry fee is \$15.00.

The Veteran Sweepstakes classes are open to all eligible Rhodesian Ridgebacks who are 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Indicate Sweepstakes and age division on the regular entry form under "Additional Classes". Entry fee is \$15.00.

Division of entry money for Puppy and Veteran sweepstakes (separately) as prizes will apply as follows: The Delaware Valley Hound Association will retain 35% of entry fees for expenses and the remaining monies shall be divided as follows among the class winners: First, 40%; Second, 30%; Third, 20%; Fourth, 10%.

NOTICE:

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: Grand Basset Griffon Vendéen and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Whippets.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: Basset Hounds and Cirneco dell'Etnas.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition (*where offered*), the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS:

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at: <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RRFGS3.pdf>

Most important to note are the following:

- Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
- Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, *regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards*. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniels (Black, ASCOB, Parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in.; over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (Longhaired, Smooth, Wirehaired), Bull Terriers (Colored, White), Manchester Terriers (Standard, Toy), Chihuahuas (Smooth Coat, Long Coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (Toy, Miniature, Standard), Collies (Rough, Smooth).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list, if the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
