DRIVING DIRECTIONS

- FROM THE EAST (Hickory, Winston-Salem, Greensboro, etc.: Travel West on I-40, Take exit 53-B ontoI-240 West towards downtown Asheville, As you cross the "French Broad River Bridge" merge into the far right lane, marked as an "Exit Only" for Exit 3-B (labeled Westgate and Resort Dr), Merge into the right lane as you pass the Westgate Shopping Center, Crown Plaza driveway is IMMEDIATELY as youround the curve
- FROM THE WEST (Knoxville) Travel East on I-40, Follow signs for I-240 East towards Asheville (left exit), Merge into the left lane and take exit 3A, This will merge you onto Patton Ave., At the 2nd light make a right onto Regent Park Blvd (between Denny's and Pizza Hut), The road will bear right and our entrance will be immediately on the left (before entering Sam's Club parking lot), Follow the road past the golf course to the main entrance
- FROM THE NORTH (Johnson City, TN): Travel South on Hwy 19/23 (also known as I-26 East) Merge onto I-240 West, Stay in the right lane as you merge, marked as an "Exit Only" for Exit 3-B(labeled Westgate and Resort Dr), Merge into the right lane as you pass the Westgate Shopping Center, Crowne Plaza driveway is IMMEDIATELY as you round the curve to your right. HOTEL DOG SHOW GUIDELINES

Note: The Crowne Plaza hosts other dog show guests. Violation could result in a Bench Show Committee hearing. Guests must follow the rules below.

- A maximum of four (4) dogs allowed per room.
- Guests will be charged a one-time non-refundable dog fee of \$50.00 per stay. This fee applies to all guests with dogs.
- Dogs left unattended in a guest room must be in a crate. Plastic sheeting must be placed under each crate in the guest room area.
- Owners/exhibitors should bring their own toweling for bathing the dogs. A daily inventory for missing or damaged towels will be taken. Any necessary charges will be applied to the guest.
- carriaged towers will be taken. Any necessary charges will be applied to the guest. Bathing and/or grooming of dogs in or right outside the guest from is not allowed. The hotel will impose a \$100 penalty to anyone found grooming in this manner. The hotel has a grooming facility on the grounds, which will be available for use. Grooming is not allowed on any sidewalks. The individual guest will be responsible for any damage to a guest room or any hotel property. This includes, but is not limited to, replacement costs for carpeting if odors or stains cannot be removed with
- traditional cleaning methods.
- Dogs are to be on leash at all times when out of the guest room.
- The hotel and the show committee will investigate any problem areas that are outlined above. Any guest not following the above guidelines will be asked to check out of the hotel without refund.
- Dogs are not allowed in the following public areas: the lobby, restaurant, lounge, Holidome, and the respective hallways to the areas listed.
- There will be a \$100 fee for any removal of quest room furniture. All furniture must remain in the room at all times.
- Extension cords are not allowed to be plugged in to rooms from a vehicle, trailer, or camper in the parking
