

Bred-by-Exhibitor Class

- All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club.
- 2. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- 3. To exhibit in the class, family members must be a breeder & owner of record.

NON REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Dogs, 7 years and under 10 years Veteran Dogs, 10 years and older (Same classes for Bitches)

(Effective March 1, 1992, neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible to enter these classes)

Field Class Dogs, Field Class Bitches - Open to any English Cocker Spaniel eligible to regularly compete at a dog show that has earned the ECSCA Working Dog (WD) or Working Dog Excellent (WDX) tille, or an AKC Field Championship (FC), Hunting Title (JH, SH, MH) or has placed in a stake at an AKC Cocker/ English Cocker Spaniel Field Trial. Judging will be on conformation only, and the winner of the Field Dog and the Field Bitch classes may compete for Best of Breed Competition if otherwise undefeated in a breed class at this show.

Best of Breed Competition

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. While the merit of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determined if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under *Dog Show Rules*, AKC policy or the Standard for the breed. If the Stud Dog or Get are not entered in one of the other classes at this show for which it is eligible, the regular entry fee of \$35.00 must be paid for each. Entry fee for the Stud Dog Class as an "Additional Class" is \$29.00 for the unit.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. Note; in Accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8, a neutered male may be entered in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

The Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes that are traditionally judged after Best of Breed has concluded, will be judged on Wednesday following the Breed education activities. Ms. Debbie Mason will judge both classes. The entry criteria remain the same as stated above.

Brace Class - For Two (2) dogs of the same breed and which must have one common owner and be presented by a maximum of two handlers. All Braces must be entered in the Brace Class and shown in the ring atl the same time. Dogs may be entered for Brace Class competition only or as an additional entry. The dogs comprising Brace must be named at the time of the entry. In making entries for "Brace Class only", all particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space for "Additional Classes". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated. "Brace No. 1", Brace No. 2". Entry Fee for Brace as a first entry is \$35.00 per dog and \$29.00 for the unit as an "Additional Entry".

Team Class - Same as Brace Class, except for Four (4) dogs of the same breed which must have one common owner and be presented by a maximum of four handlers. Entry fee for Team as a first entry is \$35.00 per dog and \$29.00 for the unit as an "Additional Entry". As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace and Team Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards, with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three first place awards in a Novice class in a licensed or member show, with competition present, in the Novice Class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open Class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NOTICE

Juniors with a dog also entered in another class offered at this show who substitute a dog not entered in this show must remit the difference between Junior Showmanship Only and Junior Showmanshp as an Additional Class Entry Fee. Juniors who have entered Junior Showmanship only who then substitute another dog will not be changed a further fee.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. **A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

AKC SANCTIONED 4 & UNDER 6 MONTHS PUPPY COMPETITION

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are four months and under six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. There will be a selection of Best of Breed Puppy in each Breed/Variety. All Best of Breed Puppy winners will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth. AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might
 reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than
 the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- · Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniels (Black, ASCOB, Parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in.; over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (Longhaired, Smooth, Wirehaired), Bull Terriers (Colored, White), Manchester Terriers (Standard, Toy), Chilhuahuas (Smooth Coat, Long Coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (Toy, Minature, Standard), Collies (Rouch, Smooth).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is Limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list, if the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.).
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed etrants.
