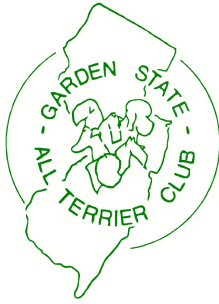

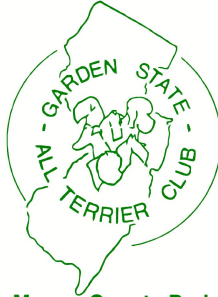

All dogs must be on a lead not to exceed six (6) feet in length.

Parking in designated areas only.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - none will be mailed.

DO NOT LEAVE dogs unattended on grooming tables.

Overnight Parking

Overnight parking facilities will be available on show grounds beginning on Thursday, May 2, 2024. The RV Parking Regulations and Reservations and the Prime Parking Reservations are Bucks County and Trenton Kennel Club's rules and regulations

There will be a \$5.00 parking fee on Friday for exhibitors; charged and collected by Bucks County and Trenton Kennel Clubs. GSATC does not receive this money.

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: AMERICAN STAFFORDSHIRE, IRISH TERRIERS, KERRY BLUE TERRIER (Ramp required), MINI BULL TERRIER (Ground/Table), SOFT COATED WHEATEN TERRIER, STAFFORDSHIRE BULL TERRIER. This extends to all conformation competitions at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situations to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breed

All Regular Classes are divided by sex and are offered for all breeds or varieties unless otherwise noted in the Breed List. Where classes are further divided by color, weight or other breed characteristics, it is so indicated in the Breed List and the class division **MUST** be indicated on the entry form.

Bred-by-Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility

- All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.
- Bred-by-Exhibitor, Puppy is for dogs over 6 months and under 12 months of age who are eligible for the Bred-by-Exhibitor class.

Amateur-Owner-Handler - For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler.

Non- Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

To Be Eligible for Best Bred By Exhibitor the appropriate box on the entry form must be checked ONLY by the Best of Breed/Best of Variety Entrants.

Best Bred By Exhibitor will be open to the winners of the Bred By classes and any dogs in the Best of Breed/Variety competition shown by their breeder/owner. Every dog entered at this event in the Best By Exhibitor class or for Best of Breed/Variety competition is eligible for the Best Bred By Exhibitor Competition, if the entry is shown by a breeder and owner of record. All dogs in competition for Best Bred By Exhibitor must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club. Dogs in competition for Best Bred By Exhibitor must be handled throughout the entire breed competition by a breeder and owner of record. No handler change will be permitted for the purpose of becoming eligible for the Best Bred By Exhibitor competition. Dogs competing in the Best By Exhibitor Group must be handled throughout by a breeder and owner of record. Judge will award First through Fourth in the Bred By Exhibitor Group.

Dogs entered in Best Bred by Exhibitor in breed competition will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in Best Bred by Exhibitor in breed. Eligible dogs will be identified by a pound sign(hashtag)# in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog.

Best Bred By Exhibitor in Terrier Group Competition will take place just prior to judging of the Terrier Group.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

**A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

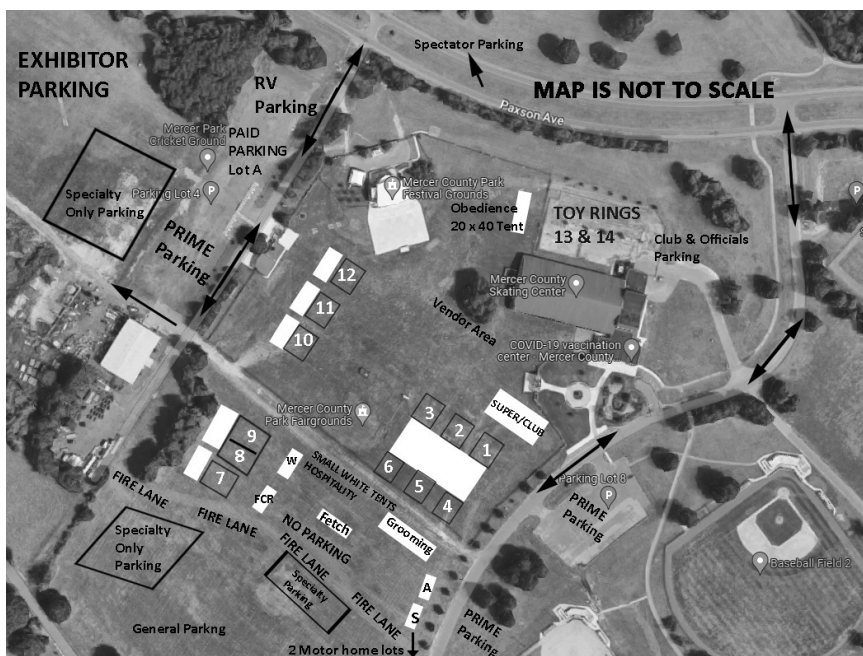
