### **BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

**Awards of Merit** - At the judge's discretion, up to three Awards of Merit to dogs competing in the Best of Breed competition. Not eligible for Award of Merit are Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Best of Winners, Winners Dog & Winners Bitch.

There will be competition for Best Puppy and Best Bred by Exhibitor.

### **GAIT**

**Gait Class** - Following Best of Breed, dogs entered in the Gait class will be judged by Mr. Wille. The winner of this competition will exemplify the best Irish Wolfhound gait as described in the Irish Wolfhound Standard of Excellence. Dogs **MUST** be entered in another class at this show.

### **Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries**

*Note: Non-Regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.*

**Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class:** Each entry is allowed two to four get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying

to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

**Brace Class:** Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs **MUST** be entered in another class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

**Team Class:** Same rules as Brace Class. Substitute "Four" for "Two" and "Team" for "Brace."

**PARADE OF VETERANS** - Dogs in this class may or may not be entered in a regular class of this show, however, all dogs must be 6 years or older on the day of the show. The Class will not be judged and each entry will receive a medallion and a commemorative certificate.

**MOVE-UP POLICY FOR THE SPECIALTY AND TRIALS** — The Club will permit a move-up to the next level class in accordance with AKC regulations. The request for a move-up must be made in writing and presented to the Show Secretary or Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the specified event, show or trial. Move-up forms will be available at the Secretary's Table.

  - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is Limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
  - (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list, if the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
  - A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3).
  - Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
