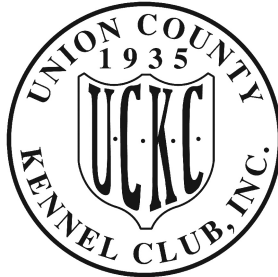

GARDEN STATE PARKWAY

FROM THE NORTH - Take Exit 123 to US 9 South.

Take left exit ramp south, exit at 25B NJ 79 South.

Turn left on Kozloski Rd,

Turn Right into park.

FROM THE SOUTH - Take Exit 100B (toward Freehold).

Go West on Hwy 33.

Follow Hwy 33 to Exit Halls Mill Road North.

Road name changed to Kozloski Road.

Follow signs to Park on left.

STATE HIGHWAY 9
