Veteran Classes, For any dog or bitch which is 8 years old or older prior to the date of this show. Classes shall be divided: 8 years and under 10 years, 10 years and over. Sexes divided.

Hunting Retriever Dogs and Bitches - For Dogs and Bitches that have earned a Junior, Senior or Master Hunter title under AKC rules.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record; Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of a show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the American Kennel Club.

Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of judging.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dog and two (2) of his get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of get. The Stud Dog and his get shall be considered as one entry and require only one class fee. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Get only are to be judged based on the merits of the Get. The Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed, other Non-Regular class or entered for Stud Dog class only.

Brood Bitch Class: For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood

Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the Produce. Produce only are to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce. The Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed, other Non-Regular Class, or entered for Brood Bitch Class only.

Chapter 14, Section 9 of the Dog Show Rules provides that "a castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".

Parade of Titleholders - Fee - \$10.00

Judges' Award of Merit - This award is given at the Judge's discretion.
