Exhibitor Information

Exhibitor Entrances - The Exhibitor Entrances are located along the rear of the building.

EXHIBITOR PARKING - All vehicle parking is on hard-top surface. All parking is at your own risk. Show-giving Club assumes no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicle, its contents or dogs. Fire lanes must be kept open at all times and will be under constant surveillance. Unauthorized or illegally parked vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense. Co-operation with all parking personnel including following instructions and directions is required. Failure to do so may result in the withdrawal of your parking privileges on the grounds for the show.

HANDICAP PARKING - Limited handicap parking will be available only upon proof of valid placard or license. These spaces will provide easy access to the building.

BUILDING ACCESS HOURS - Thursday, March 21, 2024 at 2:00 P.M. There will be security provided and the building will be locked at 11:00 P.M. on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings and reopened at 6:00 A.M. each morning. Dogs must be removed by 7:00 P.M. Sunday, March 24, 2024.

UNLOADING - Unloading will be allowed only in designated areas.

CANINE COURTESY - All dogs shall be kept under control at all times! Please no Flexi Leads on Show Grounds. YOU are responsible for picking up after the animals in your care. **PLEASE EXERCISE DOGS IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. ALL regulations** will be enforced by the Grounds Committee.

CRATE & GROOMING AREA - Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their grooming area clean, **including at the close of the weekend.** Anyone not cleaning up after themselves in the grooming area will be subject to a BENCH SHOW HEARING.

All crates, grooming tables and other equipment must be brought into the building through the EXHIBITORS' ENTRANCE. An area will be provided for crates and grooming. **CRATES MUST BE STACKED.** The grooming of dogs in areas other than the Crate or Grooming Section is prohibited. **Crates & Grooming Tables** are permitted in designated areas only. **NO SOFT-SIDED CRATES will be permitted. Due to the number of crates and grooming tables, chairs will not be permitted in the handlers' section. NO PRIVATE EXERCISE PENS OR LARGE RUGS ARE PERMITTED IN THE EXPO BUILDING.**

All trash and litter must be placed in containers provided.

NO DOGS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE RESTROOMS. Disposal of grooming residue (fur, etc) in the restrooms is PROHIBITED.

Food for exhibitors and spectators will be available.

You MUST use a SEPARATE entry blank if you are entering your dog in a different class on different days. (e.g. Open Class on Day 1 and American-bred Class on Day 2), or, if you are entering an additional class on any of the days (Open Class on Day 1 and Open Class plus Junior Showmanship on Day 2 or Open Class and Novice A Obedience on Day 2.)

Awards of Merit - Each Day

In recognition of these major entries, the March Madness Cluster offers **AWARDS OF MERIT** in recognition of the quality dogs who are in serious contention for the top awards. It is entirely the judge's decision whether to give all of the available Awards of Merit, only some, or none. National Owner-Handled Series
Friday, Saturday & Sunday
March 22, 23 & 24, 2024

The AKC Owner/Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners who are not professional handlers. This series of special competitions will be offered at dog shows across the country.

All dogs that are owner/handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers' meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner/Handler eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the competition by an eligible owner. Professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.**

The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled Group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition ineligible and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible undefeated exhibits of the owner sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are both ineligible and Select Dog and Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all dogs of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are ineligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners Competition.

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.

RAMP & TABLE BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: AMERICAN WATER SPANIEL, BOYKIN SPANIEL, ENGLISH SPRINGER SPANIEL, FIELD SPANIEL, LAGOTTO ROMAGNOLO, NS DUCK TOLLING RETRIEVER, WELSH SPRINGER SPANIEL, GRAND BASSET GRIFFON VENDEEN, WHIPPET (Ground/Table thru 3/28/23), GERMAN PINSCHER, STANDARD SCHNAUZERS, AMERICAN STAFFORDSHIRE, IRISH TERRIERS, MINI BULL TERRIER (Ground/Table), SOFT COATED WHEATEN TERRIER, STAFFORDSHIRE BULL TERRIER, FINNISH SPITZ, ENTLEBUCHER MOUNTAIN DOG, FINNISH LAPPHUND, ICELANDIC SHEEPDOGS, MUDI (or Table), NORWEGIAN BUHUND, POLISH LOWLAND SHEEPDOG, SPANISH WATER DOG, NORRBOTTENSPETS (Misc.)

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: CLUMBER SPANIEL, SUSSEX SPANIEL, BASSET HOUND, CIRNECO DELL'ETNA, KERRY BLUE TERRIER, BULLDOGS, CHINESE SHAR-PEI, CHOW CHOW, KEESHONDEN

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dogshows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breed.

Stud Dog - For Stud Dogs and two of the Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular or non-regular classes, or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class Competition Only at the regular entry fee. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. As the judge's decision in the following classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having one in these classes.

Brood Bitch - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

SETTER (ENGLISH)- SATURDAY

Stud Dog/Brood Bitch - See above

POINTER (GERMAN SHORTHAIRED)- SATURDAY

Field Trial Class - Dogs/Bitches who have a Field Trial Placement.

Hunt Test Class - Dogs/Bitches who have met the requirements for JH SH or MH.

ALL 3 DAYS PEKINGESE

Stud Dog - for Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Stud Dog only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. An entry of \$15.00 will be charged for each unit making up the entry (Stud Dog and two of its Get).

Brood Bitch - Same as Stud Dogs but substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class - A brace is comprised of two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.

Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility

All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are accepted for AKC registration.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to entry the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Competition must exist for Best Junior Handler.

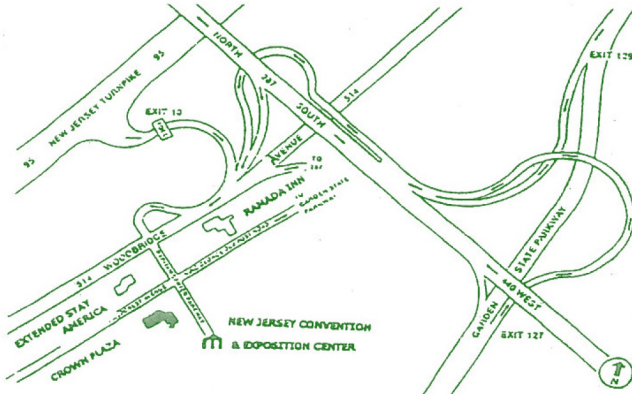

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
