Bred-by-Exhibitor Class eligibility: All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The Person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Classes - For any dog or bitch which is 8 years old or older prior to the date of this show. Classes shall be divided: 8 years and under 10 years, 10 years and over. Sexes divided.

Hunting Retriever Dogs and Bitches - For Dogs and Bitches that have earned a Junior, Senior or Master Hunter title under AKC rules.

Field Trial Dogs and Bitches - Class for dogs & class for bitches that have placed in a Regular Derby, Gundog, or an All-Age Stake at a licensed AKC Field Trial.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record; Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of a show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the American Kennel Club.

Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of judging.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dog and two (2) of his get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of get. The Stud Dog and his get shall be considered as one entry and require only one class fee. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Get only are to be judged based on the merits of the Get. The Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed, other Non-Regular class or entered for Stud Dog class only.

Brood Bitch Class: For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the Produce. Produce only are to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce. The Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed, other Non-Regular Class, or entered for Brood Bitch Class only.

Chapter 14, Section 9 of the Dog Show Rules provides that "a castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".

Judges' Award of Merit - This award is given at the Judge's discretion. The Award of Merit winners will be selected after the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed & Best of Winners awards are made. All dogs remaining in the competition are eligible for an Award of Merit. The number of awards will be up to 10% of the Best of Breed entry

The New Jersey Pine Barrens Golden Retriever Club (NJPBGRG) Challenge Trophies for Best of Breed-Kathy Uhrman Memorial Trophy, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed and Highest Scoring Golden Retriever in Regular Classes are all awarded to the owner(s) of each dog receiving the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed and Highest Scoring Golden Retriever in Regular Classes awards at the NJPBGRG Annual Specialty Show. The trophies shall be received during each Specialty and must be returned by the winning Golden Retriever owner(s) two months prior to the next annual show. A deposit will also be required from the owner(s) which will be returned upon receipt of the trophy in good condition by NJPBGRG, prior to the deadline for return. Winning owners are responsible for all repairs to any damaged trophies, up to and including the replacement value. The name of each winning Golden Retriever, as well as the owner(s) name will be engraved on the appropriate trophy, prior to issue at the next Specialty. The BOB, BOS and HIT Challenge Trophies may each be either retired or rededicated by the winning owner(s) after having been won three separate times by the same exact owner(s), although it is not necessary to win with the same dog. In the event of co-ownership, the same co-owners must be identical for all three times the individual trophy is won.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Saving Spaces for vehicles not present will be strictly prohibited.
Campers and motor homes are welcomed at our site and there is ample room for parking. There are no electrical hookups.
We expect everyone to keep the show site clean and will use the right to remove from the park anyone who fails to use the provided trash cans.
Grooming space will be provided at each of the ring tents.
NO SPACE SAVING UNDER ANY TENT FOR HANDLERS NOT PRESENT. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL HAVE FINAL AUTHORITY TO APPORTION SPACE AVAILABLE.
Unentered dogs are not permitted on the Show Grounds. Bucks/Trenton Kennel Club, Inc. and the Bucks/Trenton Parks Department will not permit reinstatement examinations of dogs previously disqualified. All dogs must have updated rabies certificates and must present them upon request of Event Committee or Park Service Employee.
The Club and its Superintendent caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW GROUNDS

From North & South Via Interstate 295: Take 295 to Exit 65A, Sloane Avenue. East on Sloane Avenue to Second traffic light, Quaker Bridge Road. Cross over Quaker Bridge Road and go to next traffic light (road makes a T) and make a left onto Edinburg Road (Route 535). The name of the road changes to Old Trenton Road. Continue for about 2 miles with Mercer County Park ENTRANCE on the left.

From North Via U.S. 1: Take US 1 South of Princeton to Rt. 533, Quakerbridge Road. Bear Right off US 1 onto jug handle to cross over US 1 onto Rt. 533, Quakerbridge Road. Go to the 6th traffic light and turn left onto Hughes Drive. At the first traffic light, turn left into Mercer County Park. Follow road to event staff for parking instructions.

From South Via U.S. Route 1: Cross toll bridge into New Jersey. On U.S. 1 make first right past Quakerbridge Mail onto Quakerbridge Road (Route 533). Go to the 6th traffic light and turn left onto Hughes Drive. At the first traffic light turn left into Mercer County Park. Follow road to event staff for parking instructions.

From North (Route 130 South) or NJ Turnpike Exit 8 A: Exit 8A toward Rt. 130 South. Go to the 6th light on Route 130 South and turn right onto Old Trenton Road (Rt. 535). Go through 6 traffic lights and Mercer County Park ENTRANCE is on the right.

From South Via NJ Route 130/206: Follow Route 130 North to Route 526 in Robbinsville and turn left on to Route 526. (Corners: Costal Delta Station, Russert's Deli, Taco Bell). Turn right at the next traffic light; you are still on Route 526 with Rite Aide on your right. From this point travel 3 miles to Route 535, Old Trenton Road and turn left. The exhibitors's ENTRANCE is 1/3 mile ahead on the right.

From South Via New Jersey Turnpike: Take NJ Turnpike North to Exit 7A. Take Interstate 195 West to Exit 5B which is the first exit on Route 195 To Route 130 North/New Brunswick. Travel North on Route 130 to second traffic light and turn left onto Route 526. Proceed to the next traffic light and right onto Route 526 with Rite Aide on your right. Go 3 miles to Route 526, Old Trenton Road. Mercer County Park ENTRANCE is 1/3 mile on the right.

LIMITED TO 100 ENTRIES

AN AKC RECORDING FEE OF 50¢ & AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for the first entry of a dog & a \$3.50 service fee each additional entry of the same dog in an event will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check.

TELEGRAPH, and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. **SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR** within a reasonable time, please notify Jim Rau Dog Shows, Ltd., 610-376-1880.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2006 an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

NO GASOLINE OR DIESEL GENERATORS are not permitted within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is being conducted.
