Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers\*, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. The calendar for this class will consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. ### REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS & VISITORS

No fee at gate for entrance or parking in non-reserved spaces

Grounds will be available after 1 PM on Wednesday (May 17) for parking and outside setup.

Buildings will be available for exhibitor setup on Wednesday after 2:30 P.M.

**Electricity** is available in the grooming areas at no charge to exhibitors. Any exhibitor needing electrical power should bring an extension cord.

Exhibitor vehicles not allowed in the building.

Unloading at designated spaces located at front and back entrances.

Site Control will supervise all grooming setups, and have the final authority on the setup and usage of grooming space.

The use of soft sided crates will only be allowed when placed on top of another crate.

Site Control has the right to remove unapproved placement of equipment and chairs.

Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their grooming area.

All Exhibitors and Visitors shall respect the authority of Site Control, Event Officials and the Event Committee. Failure to do so may result in Event Committee Hearing and/or ejection from the show grounds.

All dogs MUST be kept under control at all times. We strongly suggest that Flexi-leads not be used in the grooming area or show building.

Only those dogs entered in shows will be allowed in show building.

Dogs may be left in the building overnight at owner's risk. Emergency contact phone number must be left in clear view at the crates being used.

There will be no attendant in the building overnight

Outdoor Ex-Pens will be provided. There will be no private ex-pens indoors.

Building will be open from 6:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M. each day of shows

Do not leave property unattended. The Clubs cannot be responsible for missing items.

Event Buildings and perimeters are designated as NON-SMOKING areas.

### GROOMING SPACES

Safe, adequate grooming space with access to electricity will be available at **no charge** for all exhibitors. If necessary, the Cluster will rent another space with access to electricity.

**Show & Go** space will be available at ringside - please leave the **Show & Go** area when excused to make room for others. There will be no grooming in aisles.

Dogs may arrive at ringside no sooner than 15 minutes prior to their scheduled time of judging.

AN AKC RECORDING FEE OF 50¢ & AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for the first entry of a dog & a \$3.50 service fee each additional entry of the same dog in an event will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over

EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2006 an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
