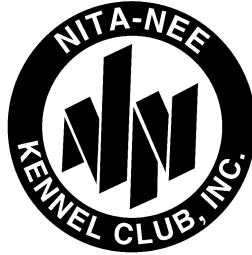

ROUTES TO THE SHOW
Grange Fairgrounds
169 Homan Lane, Centre Hall, PA 16828

The Grange Fairgrounds is located on the north side of Rt. 45 (Use Gate # 4), between Rt. 144 (Old Fort/Centre Hall) and Rt. 322 (Boalsburg, east of State College).

From I-80: Use Exit 161, south on Rt. 220, then Exit 73 to east on Rt. 322 bypass (*) left onto Rt. 45 East for approximately 8 miles, then left onto Homan Lane to Gate # 4 entrance of Fairgrounds. Dog show to the right side of fairgrounds. **NOTE:** For downtown State College, use Rt. 26, then east on Rt. 322 (business) to left on Rt. 45 East (Earlstown Road) to fairgrounds.

OR

From West - 80 E to Woodland Exit 123 then 322E toward State College to I99/US-322E Bus. Then 322E to Old Fort exit (Rt 45E) left onto Earlstown Road, approximately 8 mi, left onto Homan Lane to Fairgrounds.

From the South: (Altoona) Take I-99/Rt. 220 North to Rt. 322 East, then from (*) as above.

From the East (Harrisburg): Take Rt. 322 West, turn slight right onto Rt. 144 (not truck route) to Old Fort traffic light intersection; turn left onto Rt. 45 West for approximately 1/2 mi, turn right onto Homan Lane to Gate # 4 entrance of Fairgrounds. Dog show on the right side after entrance.
