ATTENTION EXHIBITORS!!!

No practicing in the ring at any time.

Saving space for vehicles not present will be strictly prohibited.

Campers and motor homes are welcome at our site and there is ample room for parking.

There are NO hookups. Please refer to "Important Notes" for detailed information.

Exhibitors must park in designated areas, and in no case are permitted on other areas of the show grounds that would interfere with preparation for concurrent or subsequent dog shows.

Parking in the Unloading Zone is limited to 15 minutes.

Exhibitors are encouraged to bring chairs.

Everyone is to keep the show site clean and NSGCGS reserves the right to have anyone removed from the Show Site that fails to use the proper receptacles.

Grooming space will be available.

No alcoholic beverages allowed on the Show Grounds.

NO SPACE SAVING FOR HANDLERS NOT PRESENT. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL HAVE FINAL AUTHORITY TO APPORTION SPACE AVAILABLE.

EXHIBITOR ENTRANCES

The Exhibitor Entrances are located along the rear of the building.

NO DOGS will be permitted to enter the building through the Main Door.

EXHIBITOR PARKING

All vehicles parking is on hard-top surface.

All parking is at your own risk. Show-giving Club assumes no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicle, its contents or dogs.

Fire lanes must be kept open at all times and will be under constant surveillance. Unauthorized or illegally parked vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.

RAMP INFO

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

The following breeds must be judged on a Ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

From Route 1 Southbound - Take Route 1 Exit. Exit onto Main Street and go 1/4 mile to the traffic light onto Route 514 East (Woodbridge Avenue). Turn right at the Sheraton Hotel into Raritan Center. Follow the signs to the Expo Center.

From Route 1 Northbound - After crossing the Raritan River Bridge, get into the right lane. After passing "Open Round Honda" take the third right hand exit onto Route 514 East (Woodbridge Avenue). Follow Woodbridge Avenue for 3 to 4 miles. Make a right at the Sheraton Hotel into Raritan Center. Follow the signs to the Expo Center.

From Route I-287 South - Follow Route I-287 South to the Bonhamtown ONLY, Route 514 West Exit. (This exit is just after the NJ Turnpike Exit). Follow Route 514 West to the first exit ramp marked Raritan Center. Follow the signs to the Expo Center.

From the NJ Turnpike - Follow the NJ Turnpike to Exit 10. Pay the toll, to the right, follow Route 514 West to Raritan Center. Take the first exit marked Raritan Center and follow the signs to the Expo Center.

From the Garden State Parkway Southbound - Follow the Parkway to Exit 129. Take Route I-287 North to Route 514 West to the first exit marked Raritan Center and follow the signs to the Expo Center.

From the Garden State Parkway Northbound - Follow the Parkway to Exit 127. Take Route I-287 North/440 West to Route 514 West to the first exit marked Raritan Center and follow the signs to the Expo Center.

From Route 35 and Route 9 North - Follow Routes 35 and 9 over the Edison Bridge. Bear right at the end of the bridge. Take the second exit labeled Industrial Avenue. Get into the far right land and take the Industrial Avenue Exit. Follow Industrial Avenue all the way down to Raritan Center Parkway. Make a left onto Raritan Center Parkway and follow the signs to the Expo Center.

CLOSING DATE for entries 12:00 Noon ET, Wednesday, March 6, 2024 (at Superintendent's Office) after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

THE SHOW will be open from 4:00 P.M. to Midnight.

AN AKC RECORDING FEE OF 50¢ & AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for the first entry of a dog & a \$3.50 service fee each additional entry of the same dog in an event will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

CREDIT CARD ENTRIES, REGARDLESS OF METHOD SUBMITTED, are processed through the Fax program and will be charged a \$4.00 per dog per show processing fee.

RAU DOG SHOWS accepts entries for AKC events in accordance with the latest Agreement, entry form instructions & "Rules Applying to Dog Shows". Should these rules be updated or changed the most recent AKC rules take precedent in the event of a discrepancy in this document.

CHARGEBACKS will be considered a violation of the entry agreement and will be reported to the AKC compliance department for disciplinary action. Outstanding bad debts are grounds for rejection of future entry by the club or superintendent under AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows C11 S15.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. **SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR** within a

reasonable time, please notify Jim Rau Dog Shows, Ltd., 610-376-1880.

MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO JIM RAU DOG SHOWS, LTD. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. The Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2006 an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
