★ NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ★

SHOW GROUNDS will be available Friday, Feb 9 after 4pm.

NO DOGS may be kept in the ballroom overnight.

NO PRACTICING IN THE RING at any time.

SAVING SPACE FOR VEHICLES not present will be strictly prohibited.

ALL DOGS SHALL BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL at all times! Please no Flexi Leads on Show Grounds.

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE for picking up after the animals in your care.

PLEASE EXERCISE DOGS IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.

ALL REGULATIONS will be enforced by the Grounds Committee.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE for keeping their grooming area clean, including at the close of the weekend. Anyone not cleaning up after themselves in the grooming area will be subject to a BENCH SHOW HEARING.

NO SOFT-SIDED CRATES will be permitted.

ALL TRASH AND LITTER must be placed in containers provided.

NO DOGS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE RESTROOMS.

DISPOSAL OF GROOMING RESIDUE (fur, etc) in the restrooms is PROHIBITED.

FOR SAFETY REASONS, NO BABY STROLLERS ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE BUILDING.

NO SMOKING IN THE BUILDING. ANYONE WHO SMOKES IN THE BUILDING WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.

PARENTS must be responsible for their children at all times.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2006 an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Effective January 1, 2009 - Refund and Cash award checks are void after 180 days and will NOT be re-issued.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

The Club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited whether the result of accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner and/or handler during the entire time the dog is on the Show Grounds. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control over their children on the show grounds. The Club is not responsible for theft or damage to vehicles or personal property. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, exhibitors and spectators but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dog, exhibitor or spectator participating in the show or on the show grounds.
